The Old Vicarage in Flore is a Grade II Listed ironstone house of 17th century origins and retains many period features such as sash windows with wooden shutters and flagstone floors. It comprises of three separate dwellings which include The Main House, The Stables and The Mews.

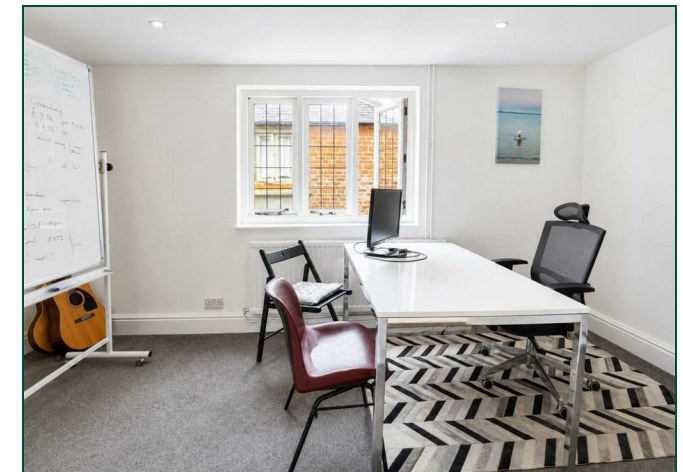
The Main House has undergone recent restoration however there are some areas which still need finishing. This was done with Grade II listing approval to restore the property to its original configuration. Formerly nine bedrooms, there are now six bedrooms four with ensuite bathrooms. Bedroom 1 (formerly three bedrooms) will need renovating including the ensuite; bedrooms 2 and 3 are both renovated however need the ensuites refitting, bedroom 4 is renovated with refitted ensuite & bedrooms 5 and 6 are also renovated. The ground floor has been fully refurbished with four reception rooms, a catering kitchen, laundry, boiler room, store and cloakroom/WC.

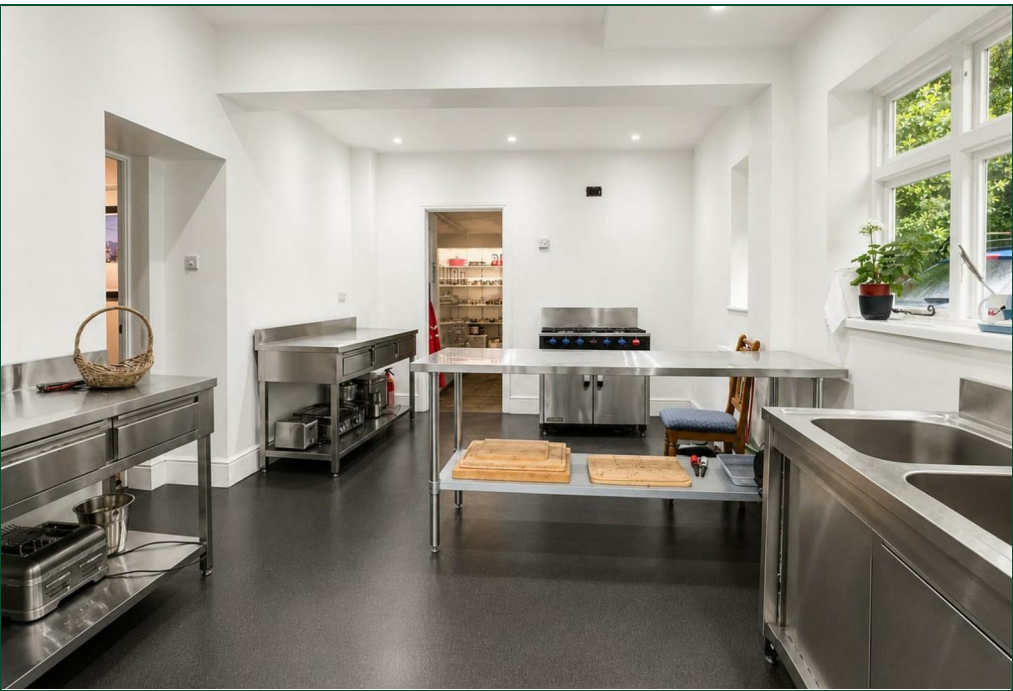
The Stables - has been refurbished to include four bedroom suites - there are two bedrooms suites to the first floor with communal kitchen and two bedroom suites to the ground floor also with communal kitchen. These are all used for Bed and Breakfast accommodation.

The Mews - also refurbished - provides two bedroom suites and a communal kitchen. These are also used for the Bed and Breakfast business.

The property provides an excellent opportunity to live in a superior period property set in tranquil private gardens with an income provided from Bed and Breakfast. The approach to The Old Vicarage is down a winding wooded driveway which then opens out into a private plot surrounded by mature trees offering a high degree of privacy. There is extensive parking on a large driveway. The formal lawn to the south side of the property overlooks the wild garden. The total plot is approximately 1.75 acres.
