Situated in the heart of the village is this wonderfully restored and beautifully presented period family house that offers nearly 3.000 square feet (total) of historically charming accommodation, including: Four generous bedrooms, three bathrooms, kitchen/breakfast room, large living room with inglenook fireplace, further lounge/dining room, conservatory, study, cloakroom plus a two storey workshop (in need of some renovation), secure (gated) off road parking for two vehicles, courtyard and a lovely enclosed stone walled garden and patio. The property is highly versatile and suits a variety of family requirements including plenty of flexible accommodation, work from home/hobby spaces, additional letting/annexe potential – and/or lots and lots of storage!

The village of Northam benefits from a good range of shops catering for day to day needs, library, Infant & Junior Schools, Health and Dental Centres, Leisure Centre, two public houses and the Burrows Country Park offers many attractive walks and stunning vistas. Nearby is Westward Ho!, with its long sandy beaches and championship Golf Course. A regular bus service provides access to the port and market town of Bideford. approximately 2 miles distant.



The Posting House is full of original 19th century charm and character and as the name suggests was a base for delivering goods/post around the village by horse and cart (the workshop previously being the stables). Since then this beautiful house has been enjoyed by many families that have made good use of the additional space and central village location.

Parking: There is secure (gated) parking for two vehicles within the courtyard as well as a nearby car park that offers off-street permit parking.

Grounds: The stone walled garden is of particular note. It is a mature space that includes a raised lawn, a lovely stone patio, some pretty borders and wonderful trees and perennials. A lovely pedestrian gate and pretty pathway leads to the traditional front door.

The courtvard at the rear has a true Mediterranean feel and could enjoy a variety of outdoor uses. There is a very appealing two storey Workshop that requires some renovation but is an impressive and vast amount of additional space suitable for many uses including: Annexe/holiday let and commercial workshop.
