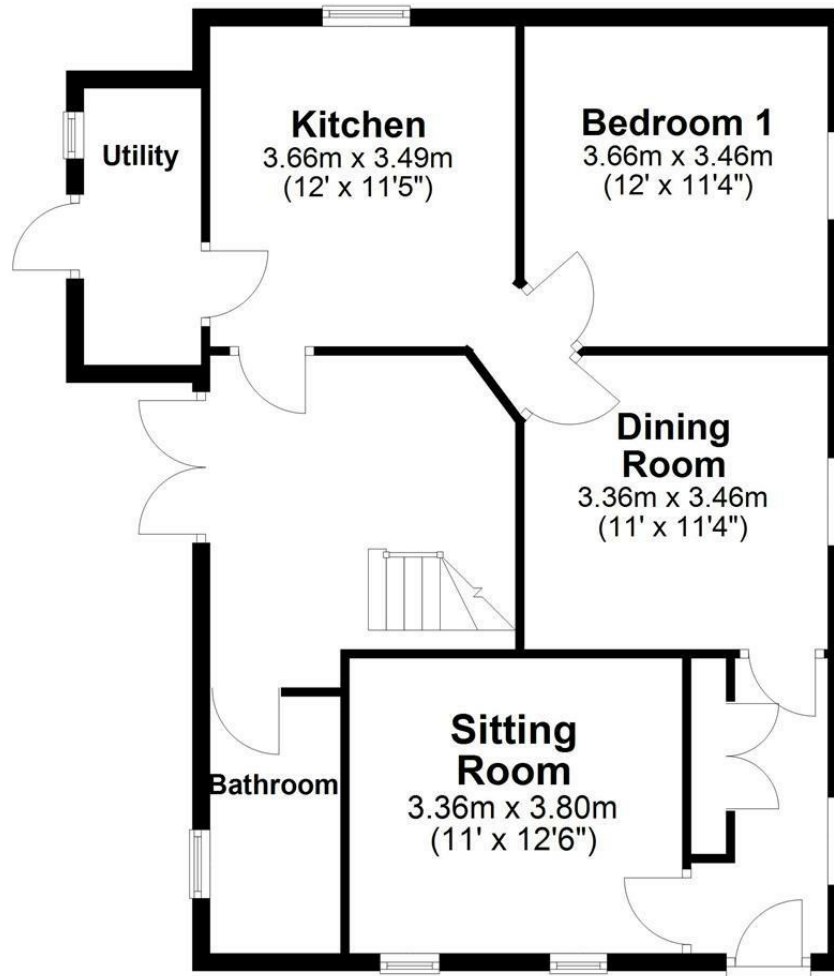

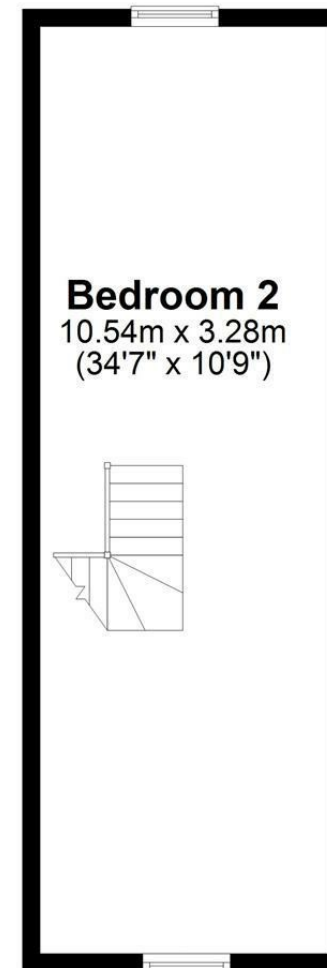
Ground Floor
