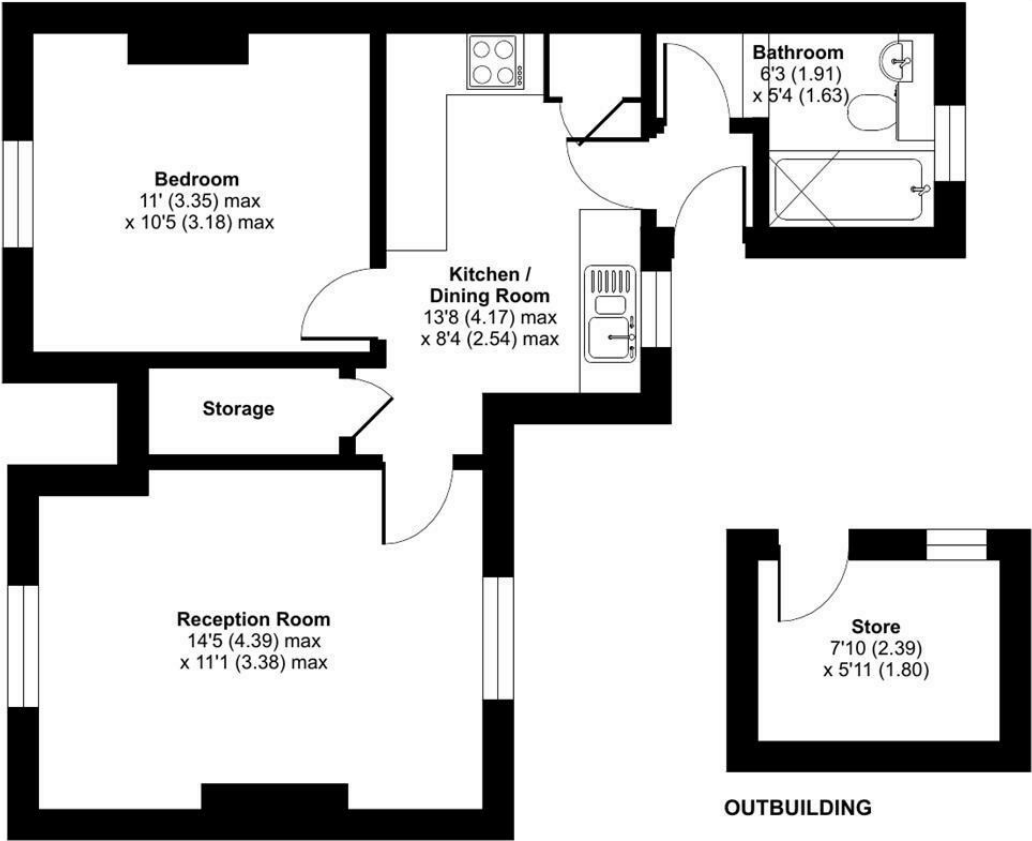
Location
