The land is fully enclosed by stone walling and rear bank with a vehicular access at the front onto Cirencester Road. It has a frontage of about 6.3m (20.7ft) and a depth of about 7.5m (24.6ft). On the land is a shipping container and lean to shed.

The extent of the land is shown edged red for identification purposes only on the aerial photo. The land adjoins garden land and there are numerous residential dwellings in the vicinity.

Situation

Tetbury is a historic wool town situated within the Cotswold Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty. The town is known for its Royal association to HM King Charles III, who resides at nearby Highgrove House. The charming and quintessential town centre has many amenities to offer including cafes, boutiques, pubs and restaurants. Essential amenities such as a supermarket and a primary and secondary school, are within the town itself.

Kemble station, a mainline to London Paddington, can be reached just c.7 miles North, and both the M4 and M5 are equidistant to the south and west, respectively, giving convenient transport links to Bath, Bristol and London.

Viewings

You can view the land from the road at any time. The gate is locked and there will be a viewing date nearer the auction.

Please do not attempt to climb onto the buildings or up the rear bank.

Online Auction

When the auction opens at 8am the day of the auction, you will be able to place bids in line with the pre-determined bid increment levels, using the bid increase (+) and decrease (-) buttons provided. It is recommended you check your web browser will allow you to bid in good time as some browsers' security can block the ability to bid. We recommend using Google Chrome when possible.

We offer property for sale by immediate, unconditional contract. This means that the fall of the electronic gavel constitutes an exchange of contracts between the buyer and seller. Both parties are legally bound to complete the transaction usually within 20 working days following the close of the auction but this will be confirmed within the legal documentation.
