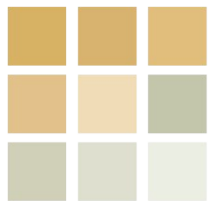

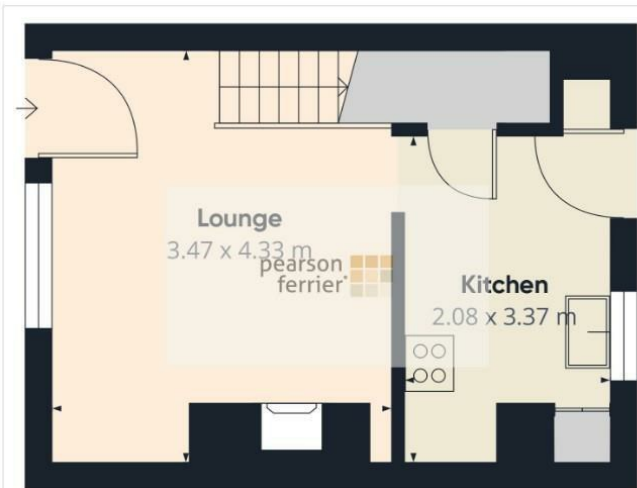

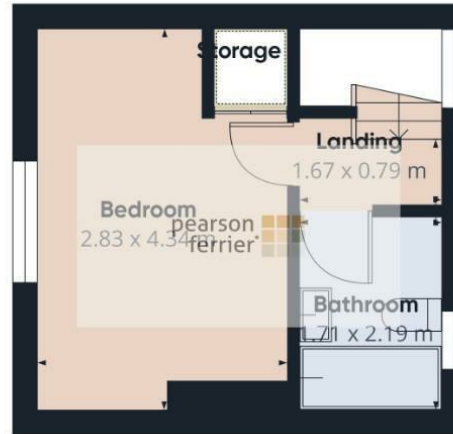

Floor 1 Building 1



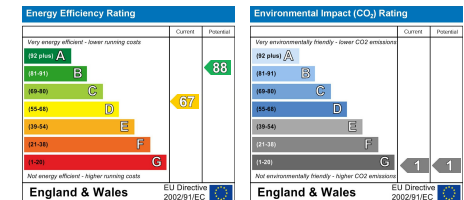
Floor 0 Building 2
