THE PROPERTY

73 Court Orchard Road is a very attractive, older style, semi-detached house in a popular and well established residential area. It was traditionally built in circa 1943 and under the current ownership has been subject to a whole number of improvements to create a lovely older style family home with all modern amenities.

The many excellent features include gas-fired central heating, uPVC windows, modern contemporary kitchen with breakfast bar and integrated appliances (gas oven, gas hob and cooker hood) and a modern bathroom.

The well presented accommodation enjoys views of Allington, Coneygar and Watton Hills and comprises:

Ground floor - Reception hall, cloakroom, through living room with feature fireplace, dining room/office/4th bedroom, kitchen, rear lobby.

First floor - Landing, 3 bedrooms, bathroom.

The property also has the big selling feature of off-road parking and a good sized west facing rear garden with large summerhouse/studio.



OUTSIDE

Double gates onto a driveway/parking area.

Enclosed front garden designed for low maintenance and with side pedestrian access. Good sized rear garden, which is attractively landscaped and arranged in two areas, including a terrace, raised beds, two fish ponds, two timber sheds and a large summerhouse/studio with power, light and wifi.

SITUATION

The property is well located in a cul-de-sac with no passing traffic and close to open fields. Court Orchard Road forms part of the popular and well established residential area in North Allington and within easy reach of the town centre. Bridport has an excellent range of shopping and business facilities together with a twice weekly market. The immediate locality is designated as an Area of Outstanding Natural Beauty (AONB) and Allington Hill (Woodland Trust) is only a few minutes' walk away.

The popular coastal resort of West Bay and the stunning World Heritage coast is within only a few miles.

All mains services. Gas-fired central heating.

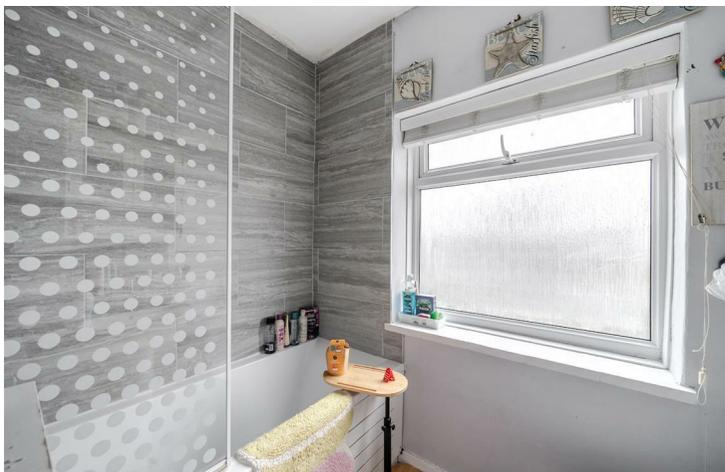

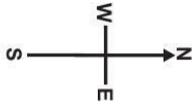
DIRECTIONS

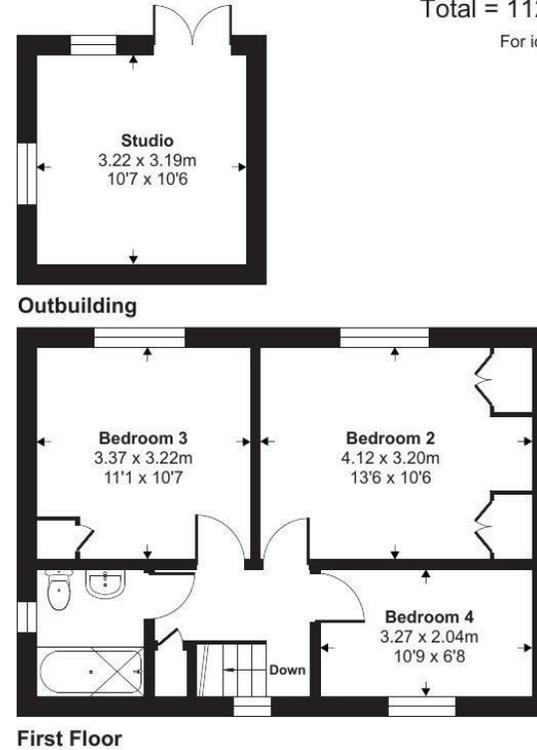
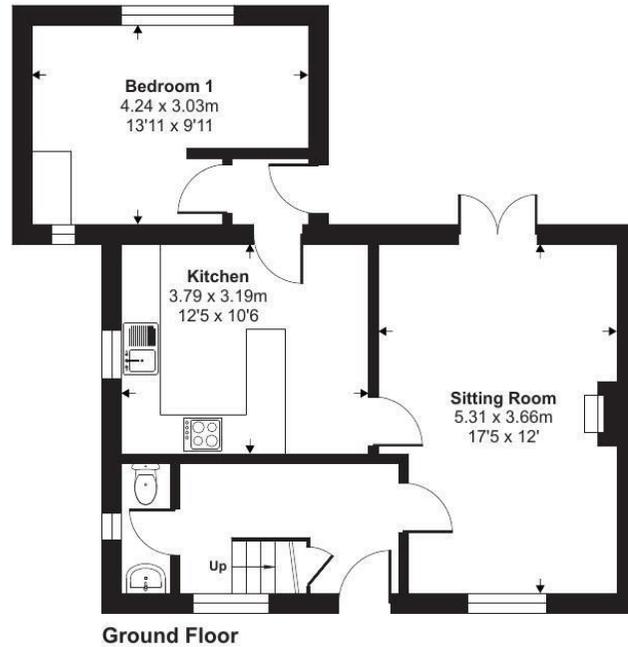
