Chapel Square, *Virginia Water*

A modern four double bedroom, three bathroom family home set in a private development within walking distance of Virginia Water's shops and station.

Downstairs there is a modern kitchen with a central island and integrated appliances, orangery which is used a dining and living room with bi-folding doors out to the garden, downstairs WC and internal access to the garage which is currently set up as a gym.

On the first floor is a formal living room with a balcony overlooking the chapel, double bedroom and a bathroom.

The second floor has the principal bedroom with a walk-in wardrobe and en suite, two further double bedrooms and a family bathroom.

Outside there is driveway parking, electrically operated door to the garage, and side access to the rear garden.

Virginia Park is a gated development which has amenities like a gym, swimming pool, ball room and tennis court managed and operated by 24 hour concierge and security.

Chapel Square is located in Virginia Park which is conveniently located in Virginia Water where the train station runs services run to London, Reading and Weybridge. Local places of interest include Ascot Racecourse, Foxhills, Guards Polo Club, Queenwood, Virginia Water Lake, Wentworth Club, Windsor Castle and Windsor Great Park. Nearby schools include ACS, Bishopsgate, Lambrook, The Magna Carta, Manorcroft, Royal Holloway, St Ann's, Salesian, St Cuthbert's and Thorpe. By road Virginia Water is convenient for the M3, M4, M25 and Heathrow Airport.

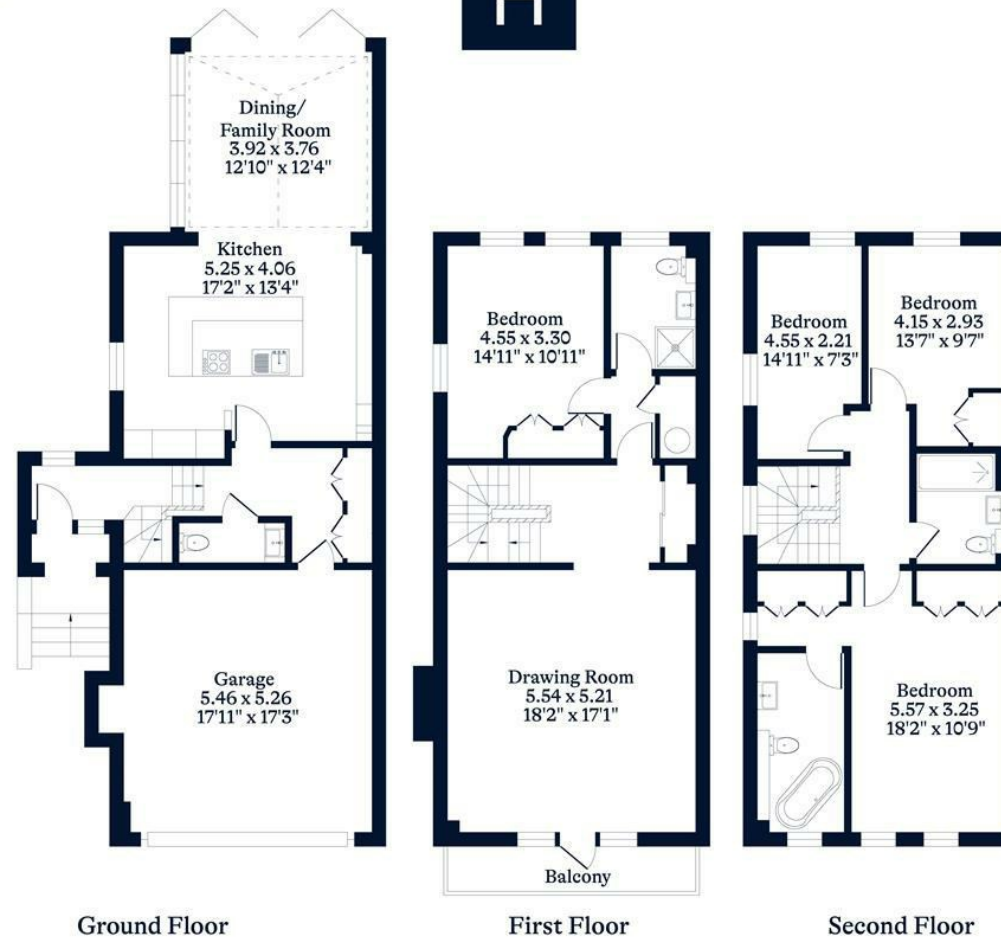
APPROXIMATE FLOOR AREA
