Occupying a wonderful position on the dramatic cliffs of Droskyn Point, this beautifully presented coastal residence enjoys lovely views over the golden sands of Perranporth Beach a favourite for keen surfers and families alike.

Designed to maximise its views the house has been arranged with reverse-level accommodation to fully embrace the panoramic seascapes. The first floor is a stunning open-plan space, perfect for entertaining and filled with natural light and framed by floor-to-ceiling glazing privacy glass offering one-way visibility. The living, dining, and kitchen areas flow seamlessly together, with French doors opening onto a generous sun terrace - an idyllic spot for alfresco dining while watching the surf roll in. The ground floor provides three well-proportioned double bedrooms, including a superb master suite and guest bedroom, both with stylish en suites. A contemporary family bathroom serves the third bedroom, and a practical utility room provides access to the enclosed rear garden.

The outside space has been carefully designed for ease and enjoyment, with a sheltered lawned garden at the rear and a large paved BBQ terrace to the side. A spacious garage provides ample storage and the driveway offers parking for two vehicles to complete this superbly positioned beachside home.

Perranporth is a vibrant seaside town set on Cornwall's north coast, renowned for its stunning three-mile sandy beach, excellent surfing, and dramatic coastal scenery.
