Looking for your first home and want something with a bit of style and character? This charming two-bedroom Victorian terraced house on Mountain View could be perfect for you.

You'll be ideally located just a short walk from the town centre with easy access via Lamplugh Road into the Lake District, enjoying open outlooks to the front and rear of the property.

The house features a front lounge, breakfast kitchen with good units installed, a front aspect double bedroom, single bedroom to the rear and a bathroom. There are some nice features throughout, most notably the sense of space created by the tall ceilings and the effect of the long windows. In addition there is a useful rear yard with an outbuilding which is ideal for storage. All of this is being offered with no onward chain and could be equally suitable as a downsize or an investment.

THINGS YOU NEED TO KNOW

Gas central heating; Hardwood double glazing.

ENTRANCE

The property is accessed via a hardwood door with brass ironmongery and a frosted glazed panel above, and that leads into:

LOUNGE

10'7" x 9'5" (3.24 x 2.88)



Fitted with gas fire within fireplace alcove with stone base and surround, pine shutters and window frame and double cupboards below window sill, laminate floor, coving and ceiling rose. Pine door with frosted glazing panel leads into:

KITCHEN

13'10" x 9'6" (4.22 x 2.90)



Fitted with a range of base and wall units in beech effect with laminate worktop over and coloured ceramic tiled splash-back. Includes stainless steel sink, space for a gas cooker, extractor fan over, plumbing for washing machine, space for fridge/freezer, wall mounted gas boiler, wood effect laminate floor, double glazed window to the rear, hardwood door to the rear with two glazed panels, coat hooks, spotlighting and stairs to the first floor.

FIRST FLOOR LANDING

With doors to both bedrooms and shower room.

BEDROOM ONE

10'7" x 9'5" (3.24 x 2.89)



Double room to the front with delightful aspect over the playing field, ceiling rose, light fitting, pine joinery.

BEDROOM TWO

13'8" x 5'2" (4.18 x 1.59)



Single room to the rear with outlook down Fitz Road and access into the loft; spotlighting.

SHOWER ROOM

7'5" x 4'1" (2.28 x 1.26)



Fitted with a modern suite in white comprising pedestal wash basin with chrome tap with ceramic tiled splash-back and low level WC. Shower with sliding door in chrome frame with wall mounted chrome shower and attachments and fitted with waterproof panelling. Plastic clad ceiling with spotlighting, chrome ladder style radiator, wood effect vinyl floor covering.

FRONT



Parking is on the road at the front. There is a small garden area to the front ideal for pots.

REAR



There is a stone built shed/store located to the rear.

From Main Street in Cockermouth travel up Station Street, staying in the right hand lane at the first set of traffic lights. At the next set of lights follow the road to the left and then immediately right onto The Level. As you follow the road around the left hand bend, the property can be found on the right hand side and can be identified by the Grisdales For Sale board.




Floor Plan
