ENTRANCE

The property is accessed via a uPVC door with a frosted glazing panel, into:

KITCHEN

10'3" x 8'10" (3.14 x 2.70)



Fitted with a range of base and wall units in white with grey laminate work surface over and white and grey ceramic tile splash-back; stainless steel sink, small breakfast bar area, space for electric cooker and space for a fridge/freezer, window overlooking the side garden, coving and plumbing for a washing machine. Glazed door leading into inner lobby.

LOUNGE



A spacious room with two curved bay windows to the side and a uPVC door to the rear, coving, two ceiling roses, feature fireplace, telephone and television points, under-stairs cupboard and stairs leading to the first floor.

DINING ROOM

14'6" x 8'9" (4.43 x 2.69)



The dining room is accessed from the kitchen via double white doors with glazing panels. With ceiling rose, coving, window to the side and one large window to the front, laminate floor, television point and centre light fitting and matching wall lights.

With frosted uPVC window to the front and fitted with walk-in shower with sliding door in chrome frame and wall mounted chrome shower and attachments; white wash basin with chrome mixer tap set into unit with double cupboards below, wall mounted mirror above and WC, black sparkly tiled ceramic floor and fitted around bath with grey tiles; extractor fan and plastic clad ceiling with spotlighting.

FIRST FLOOR LANDING

Stairs to half landing level with uPVC window to the rear and landing giving access to three bedrooms.

BEDROOM ONE

14'10" x 10'5" (4.53 x 3.20)



Double room with a front aspect.

BEDROOM TWO

9'11" x 9'1" (3.03 x 2.79)



Double room with a lovely aspect to the side with glimpses of the Lake District fells in the distance.

BEDROOM THREE

11'5" x 9'4" (3.49 x 2.85)



Double room to the side with built-in wardrobe with sliding door.

EXTERNALLY - FRONT



There is a tarmacked drive to the front with off road parking for two cars with gravelled area to the side and a small lawn area.

EXTERNALLY - SIDE





A tarmacked path leads round to the side of the property with additional paving, shillied areas and beautiful and well maintained gardens with lawns and shrub and floral borders and well stocked with a wide variety of plants.


