On the first floor, the property offers three well-proportioned bedrooms, all of a good size, along with a contemporary family bathroom finished to a modern standard.

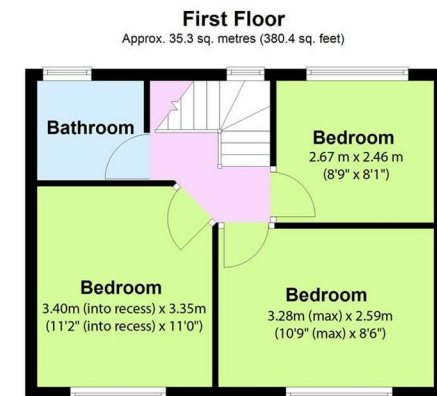
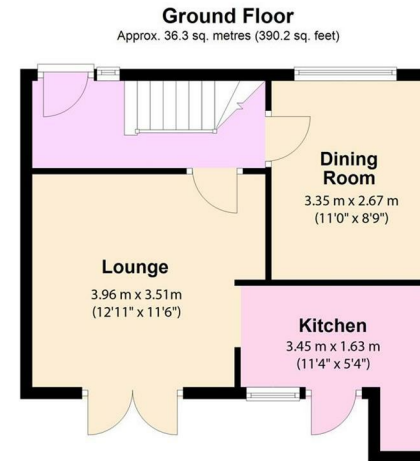
