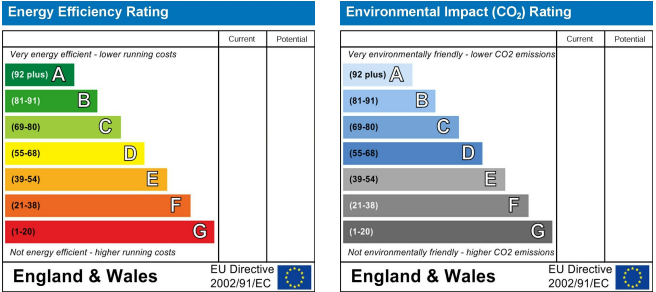
Floor Plans
