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Interior

A character cottage with a wealth of features which gives a cosy and agreeable atmosphere.

Ground Floor:

This open plan level is charming and cosy. The sitting and dining area has a whitewashed feature fireplace with terracotta tiled hearth, built in low level cupboards as well as an understairs cupboard.

The kitchen looks out to the courtyard and has space and plumbing for a slimline dishwasher and washing machine, fridge/freezer as well as having an oven and four ring gas hob. Access to the rear of the property is through the quaint stable door.

First Floor:

Two double bedrooms can be found on this floor, both with built in cupboards/wardrobes. Between these two rooms is a shower room with a concealed cistern and vanity unit with basin. Views of The Medina from first floor rear double bedroom.

Second Floor:

A large double bedroom with double aspect windows, one out towards the harbour with sea views, and an ensuite shower room.

Exterior

Adjacent to the rear of the property is a small paved sitting area with climbing roses and shrubs. Across from the property, in the gated courtyard, is the allocated parking space and a gate to the private sunken garden. Within this peaceful area is a good sized paved outside space with mature trees and plants around the perimeter and a garden store at one end, a lovely area to relax and enjoy this garden oasis.

Cowes is rich in nautical heritage and an international mecca for sailing, culminating in Cowes Week held in August each year. It has quick access to Southampton via the more modern Red Jet as well as many marinas and sailing clubs dotted along the waterfront.

Within the High Street there are two supermarkets, many boutique shops, pubs and eateries. Historical Northwood House & Park hosts weddings, fairs, concerts and conferences with outside space to enjoy walks. The chain ferry links Cowes to East Cowes where the Red Funnel car and passenger ferry to the mainland is situated.
