Offering flexible accommodation arranged over four floors, this chain-free property presents an excellent opportunity for buyers looking to create a substantial family home or investment. Previously operated as bed and breakfast, the house benefits from four bedrooms, each with its own ensuite facility, and offers scope for further improvement or extension (subject to the usual consents).

Interior

The accommodation is both versatile and well proportioned, with two reception rooms providing adaptable living and entertaining space. A kitchen sits to the rear of the property, complemented by a generous utility room, offering practical day-to-day functionality. A storm porch leads out towards the garden, adding more useful space.

Across the upper floors are four bedrooms, all featuring private ensuite bath or shower rooms and individual locks, reflecting the property's former guest accommodation use and providing flexibility for family living, multigenerational occupation, or continued investment purposes.

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Exterior

To the rear, the property enjoys a paved garden offering ease of maintenance, creating an attractive outdoor space for summer seating and entertaining. There is a storage shed and the added benefit of rear access to the street.

Cowes

Cowes is rich in nautical heritage and an international mecca for sailing, culminating in Cowes Week held in August each year, as well as many marinas and sailing clubs dotted along the seafront. It has quick access to Southampton, via the more modern Red Jet, with its international airport and excellent regular train links to London- approx 1hr 15 to London Waterloo.

'The Old Town' is set on, and around, the High Street where you can find two supermarkets, many boutique shops, pubs and eateries. Historical Northwood House & Park hosts weddings, fairs, concerts and conferences with outside space to enjoy walks.

The chain ferry links Cowes to East Cowes where you can find the Red Funnel car and passenger ferry to the mainland. Also located in East Cowes is Osborne House, the world famous summer residence of Queen Victoria and Prince Albert with it becoming her retreat after his death.

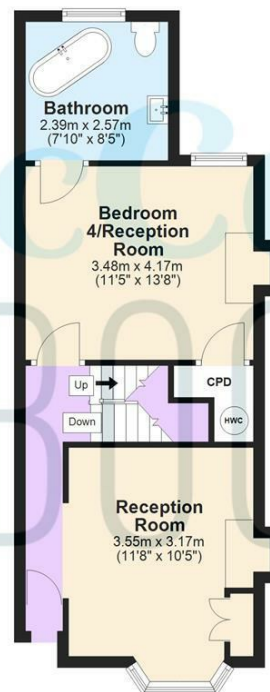
