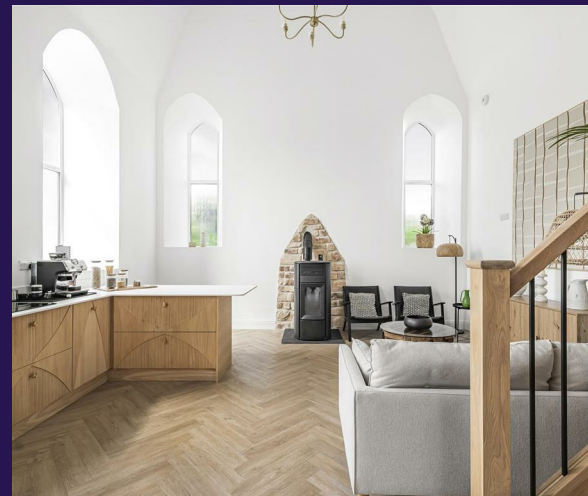

## The Property

The Cornish Chapel was built from local rubble stone with granite dressings, the chapel features pointed-arched windows, a steeply pitched roof and a gabled entrance porch, reflecting its Gothic architectural style. The interior conversions a beautifully refurbished, interior design-led conversion that seamlessly blends character features with contemporary finishes, creating a truly unique and stylish home. A carefully considered lighting scheme runs throughout, incorporating recessed downlights, wall-mounted feature lighting and a striking chandelier within the main living space. High-quality LVT flooring flows seamlessly across both floors, complemented by traditional column radiators that add warmth and character.

The impressive open-plan living space forms the heart of the home, defined by an impressive vaulted ceiling with original exposed joists, creating a sense of space and volume. Dual-aspect chapel windows flood the room with natural light, while a 12kW MCZ pellet stove provides a central focal point, efficiently heating the entire space and adding a cosy yet contemporary feel. The bespoke kitchen has been thoughtfully designed, taking inspiration from the chapel's original windows, and features elegant brushed gold sanitary ware, sleek thin-profile composite work surfaces and a peninsula unit ideal for both preparation and casual dining. Integrated appliances include a waist-height electric oven with combination oven above, four-ring electric hob, fridge/freezer and dishwasher, along with an under-mounted sink for a clean, modern finish.

A small but very much useable double bedroom is located on the ground floor, offering storage space with the potential for fitted wardrobes. The adjacent shower room is finished to a high specification, comprising a wall-mounted vanity unit with freestanding wash basin, low-level WC with dual flush and brushed gold fittings to mirror the kitchen, with pale blue tiling adding a soft but modern touch. A practical utility area provides additional work surface with space for a washer/dryer below, along with access to the LPG bottle fired boiler, while motion sensor lighting enhances everyday convenience.

A bespoke oak staircase rises from the living space to a mezzanine-level principal bedroom, creating a striking architectural feature and maintaining the open, airy feel of the chapel. A stylish borrowed light window, inspired by the original chapel design, further enhances the sense of space and light. The ensuite shower room mirrors the finish of the ground floor and is accessed via sliding door, completing this thoughtfully designed and beautifully executed home.
