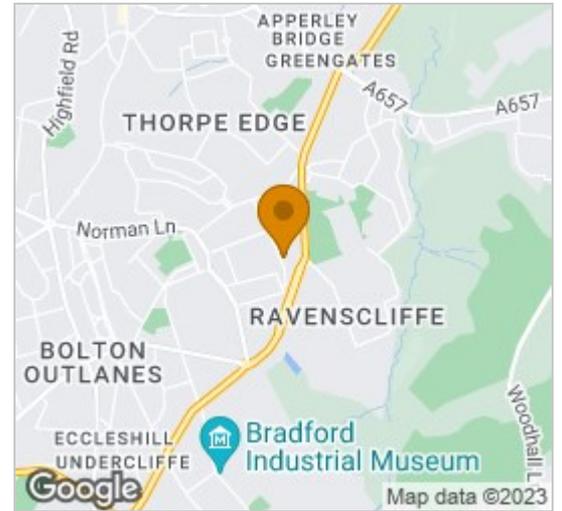

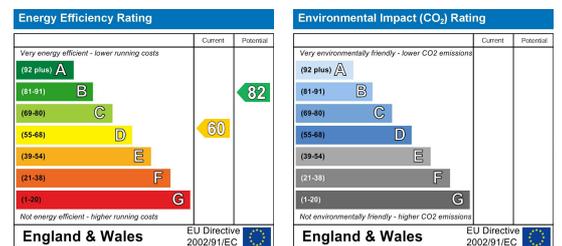
Floor Plan
