Milan House is a characterful detached seven-bedroom property offering enviable, panoramic sea views set in the highly sought after Gower village location of Overton just a short walk from Port Eynon Bay. The property also has an attached cottage which we feel would be a superb business opportunity for a buyer to use as a holiday let for example, or for extended family. Cottage comprising a lounge/dining room, kitchen, wet room, cloakroom & two double bedrooms (one with en-suite).

The versatile accommodation of the main property comprises; sitting room, living room, kitchen & dining room to the ground floor. To the first floor you have three bedrooms, study & bathroom. To the second floor you have a further two bedrooms and shower room. The attached annex comprises; lounge/dining room, kitchen, wet room, cloakroom, two double bedrooms and en-suite. All sash windows have been renovated with a Ventrolla system. You have to the rear an ornamental garden. Detached garage with workshop and coal store. 


With stairs to the second floor. Doors to bathroom, bedrooms one, two, three & study. Radiator.


Floor Plan
