It's not often you get the chance to live in a Grade II* listed building — but with this Victoria Mill apartment in Miles Platting, now's your opportunity.

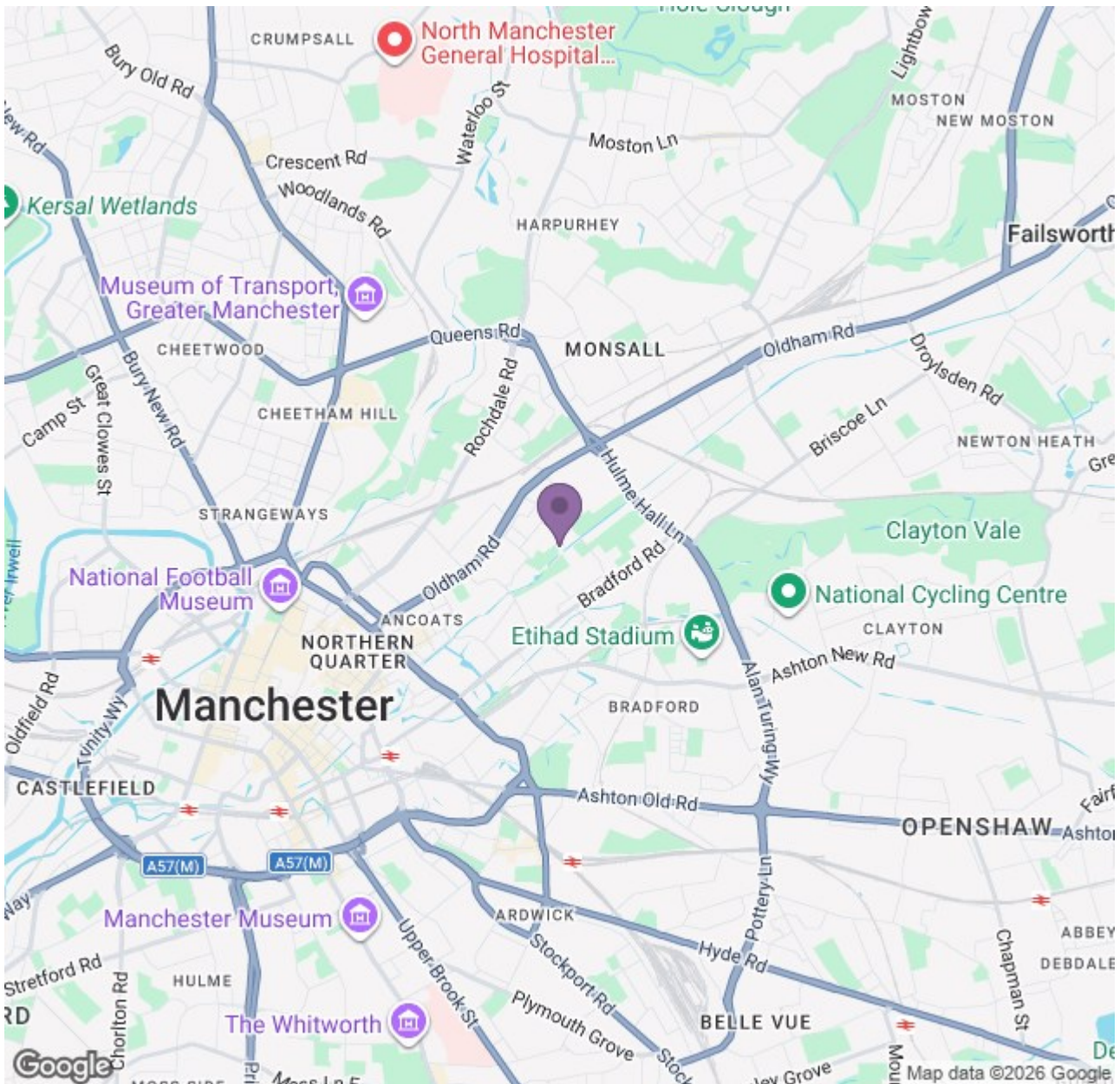
