Entrance Hallway

Front entrance door to the entrance hallway. Carpeted staircase to the first floor landing. Single pendent light. Storage cupboard. Double panelled radiator. Door to under stair storage cupboard. Door to

Double glazed window to the front elevation with secondary glazing. Single panelled radiator. Gas fire place on a tiled hearth and stone surround with mantle over. Two additional single panelled radiators. Obscure glass panelling divide with door leading through to the

Single pendent light. Double panelled radiator. Aluminium patio sliding doors to the rear garden. Sliding door to the

Two florescent strip lights. Square top work surface with stainless steel sink and side drainer. Electric four ring hob. Oven and grill. A range of base units. A range of wall units. Ceiling light. Obscure double glazed window to the side elevation. Panelled bath with shower mixer tap. Pedestal wash hand basin. Single panelled radiator. Heated towel rail.

Ceiling light. Low level WC. Obscure double glazed window to the side elevation.

Bedroom Two

Single pendent light. Double glazed window to the rear elevation. Single panelled radiator. Built in storage cupboard.

Single pendent light. Double glazed window to the front elevation. Single panelled radiator.

Bedroom Three

8'10 x 7'11 (2.69m x 2.41m)

Single pendent light. Double glazed window to the front elevation. Single panelled radiator.

Outside Front

Block paved driveway for approximately three vehicles in front of the garage with up and over door. Side access leading to the rear.

Enclosed relatively private garden. Mainly laid to lawn with a timber framed shed.

Royal Wootton Bassett

Royal Wootton Bassett is a thriving Wiltshire Market Town with a population now totalling approximately 12500. The town is generally considered to date from the 681 AD Malmesbury charter, although it may have existed in Roman times. In the 13th century, Alan Bassett created the layout of the 'new' town as he sought to enlarge his then small settlement of Wootton, and thereby gave rise to the present name of Wootton Bassett.

Royal Wootton Bassett is a lively self-contained community with a wide variety of local schools, shops, services and leisure facilities including its own sports centre, the 'Wiltshire Golf Course', just a mile outside of town and a restored stretch of the Wilts and Berks Canal.
