Floor Plan



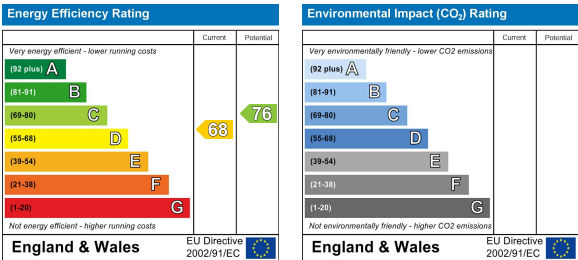
