Imperial Wharf Marina Fulham SW6

A rare opportunity to own a beautiful piece of Dutch maritime history, currently occupying an exceptional mooring at Imperial Wharf on the River Thames.

De Twee Gezusters, meaning "The Two Sisters", is a historic Dutch Skütsje barge built in Holland in 1921. Her name refers to two mermaid sisters, reflected in a charming carving on board.

Originally built to transport tulips along the Dutch canals, she was converted in the 1950s before sailing across the Channel to England in the 1970s.

For many years, De Twee Gezusters was moored in Aldeburgh, Suffolk, where she was used as a musician's practice space and occasionally motored along

the River Alde. Around ten years ago, she journeyed around the coast and up the Thames to her current home at Imperial Wharf.

She now occupies a wonderful position at the end of the pier, enjoying open views and beautiful sunrises and sunsets over the water.

For the past decade, the barge has been used as a writing studio, occasional shoot location and peaceful summer retreat, offering an inspiring and atmospheric space full of history and character.

De Twee Gezusters has been well cared for; however, her engine has not been used since her journey to London and would require a complete overhaul before being put back into service. The asking price reflects the work required.

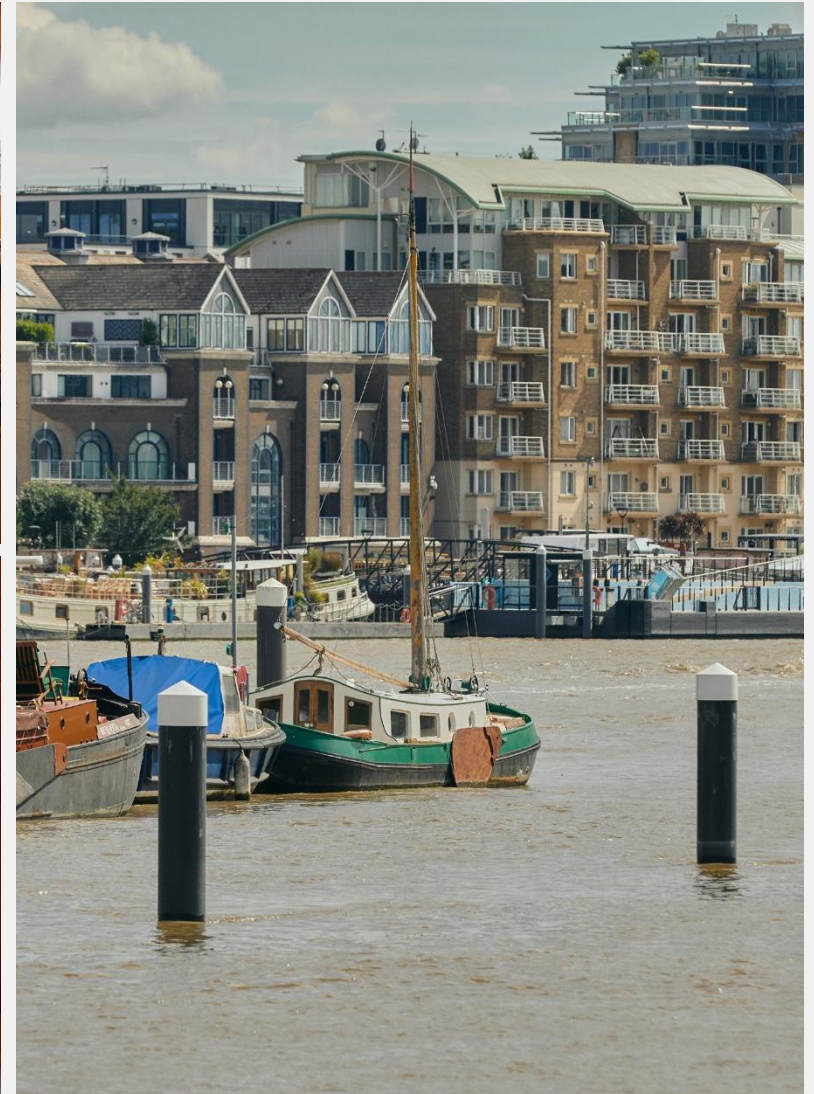
