A truly exceptional and rare 1930s steel barge, reimagined as one of London's most remarkable contemporary houseboats, quietly moored within the prestigious setting of St Katharine Docks Marina. A near 50 ft foredeck provides a generous platform for al fresco dining and entertaining, while above, the expansive open-plan upper deck unfolds into a striking sequence of reception, kitchen and dining spaces, framed by wide dockside views and centred around a dramatic atrium staircase. Below, the lower deck reveals a further reception area with direct access to a rib

and jet-ski platform, alongside five beautifully proportioned double bedrooms, each with direct or shared en suite facilities. Recent improvements include new wool carpeting, a replaced boiler, integrated LED lighting and full redecoration throughout. Set to the rear, a newly created office enjoys uninterrupted views towards Tower Bridge and is thoughtfully separated from the main living spaces, offering an ideal balance between work and retreat. Please note: the mooring is held under a licence agreement rather than leasehold. Further details available on request.
