Constructed around 1985, this two-bedroom cluster home measures in the region of 53.6sqm / 577.3sqft and provides accommodation over two levels.

To the ground floor the property comprises of a large reception room with window overlooking the rear garden, a larger storage cupboard beneath the stairs providing space for shoes and coats and in turn leads onto the kitchen. The kitchen of the property is in a shaker style, has a tiled splash back, offers storage at both eye level and base level and has integrated appliances which include a fridge/freezer, electric oven and a four-ring hob.

To the first floor is a light and airy landing area with built in storage and two generous bedrooms, both overlooking the rear garden. Serving each bedroom is a tiled bathroom suite with a panelled bath, a shower over, a pedestal sink basin and a low level WC.

Externally – the property has resident parking off road. The rear garden of the property is laid predominantly to lawn and has a variety of trees, shrubs and plants located within the mature borders across the perimeter of the plot.

Previously rented out for £1350 per calendar month, this two bedroom home provides a rental yield in the region of 6%.

Location

Histon is widely acknowledged as being one of the most sought-after villages north of Cambridge. Its particularly convenient location just 3 miles from Cambridge city centre adds to its popularity and communications are first class, the A14 and M11 being within a few minutes' drive. Histon is served by Cambridgeshire County Council's Guided Busway with an estimated journey time to the Science Park of approximately 3 minutes and is a 10-minute cycle. It is also conveniently located for Cambridge North railway station.

The village boasts many local facilities including excellent schooling for all ages from pre-school to sixth form, including the well regarded Impington Village College. Good local shopping is available in the village and there is a regular bus service to Cambridge. Girton Golf Club is also within a few minutes' drive.

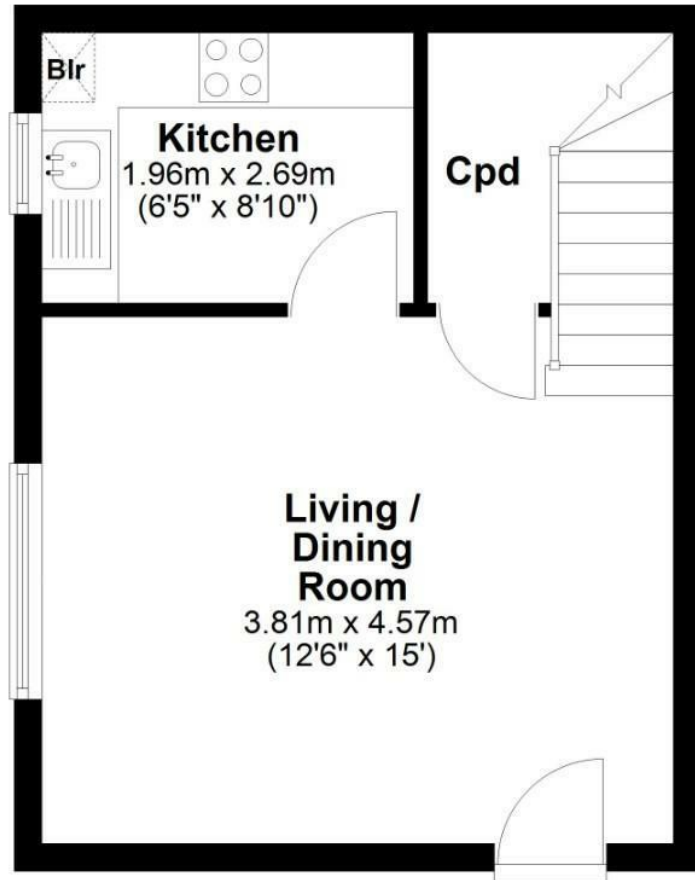

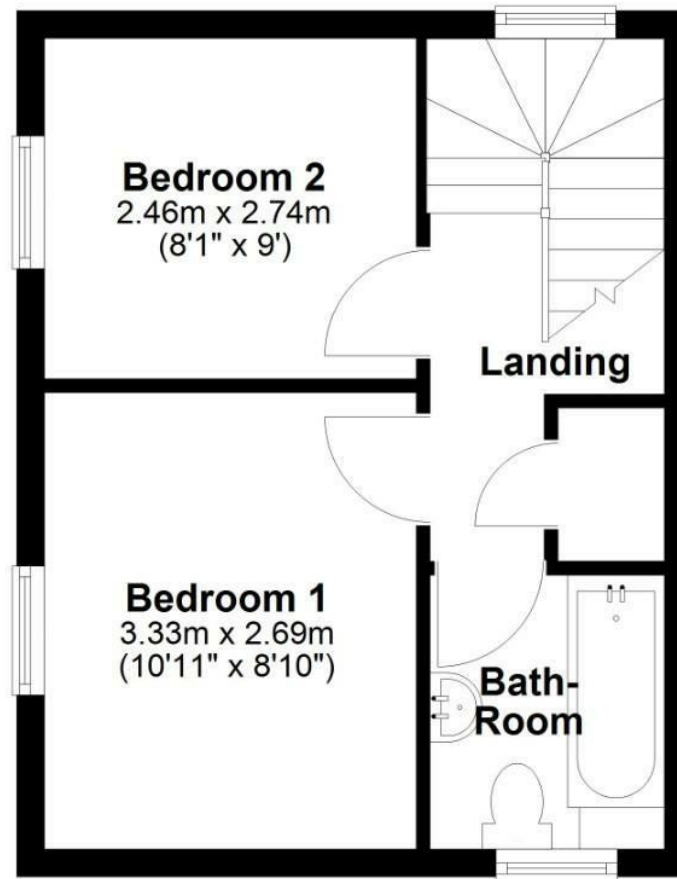
Ground Floor
