## Situation

Adjacent to Dinas Mountain and is accessed over a hardsurfaced track of approximately Two Thirds of a Mile off the Llanllawer to Dinas Mountain Council Maintained District Road.

The popular coastal village of Dinas Cross is within 3 miles or so and has the benefit of a good General Store, 2 Public Houses, a Fish and Chip Shop Takeaway, 2 Chapels, a Church, Petrol Filling Station/Post Office/Store, a Village/Community Hall and a Licensed Restaurant at Pwllgwaelod.

The well known Market Town of Fishguard is within 5 miles or so of the Property and has the benefit of a good Shopping Centre together with a wide range of amenities and facilities including Secondary and Primary Schools, Churches, Chapels, a Building Society, Hotels, Restaurants, Public Houses, Cafes, Takeaways, Art Galleries, a Library, a Cinema/Theatre and a Leisure Centre.

The North Pembrokeshire Coastline at Pwllgwaelod is within 4 miles or so of the Property and also close by are the other well known sandy beaches and coves at Aberbach, Cwm-yr-Eglwys, Aberfforest, Aber Rhigian, Cwm, The Parrog and Newport Sands.

Dinas Cross stands within the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park which is a designated area of Outstanding Natural Beauty and protected accordingly. Dinas Mountain adjoins the Land on the Northern boundary and provides excellent Walking, Rambling, Hacking and Pony Trekking facilities.

Within a short drive is the well known Market and Coastal Town of Newport which benefits of a good range of Shops, a Primary School, Church, Chapels, Public Houses, Hotels, Restaurants, Cafés, Take-Away's, Art Galleries, a Memorial/Community Hall, Library, Tourist Information Centre, a Dental Surgery and a Health Centre.

The well known Market Town of Cardigan is some 16 miles or so north east, whilst the County and Market Town of Haverfordwest is some 20 miles or so south.

The County and Market Town of Haverfordwest has the benefit of an excellent Shopping Centre together with an extensive range of amenities and facilities including The County Council Offices and The County Hospital at Withybush.

There are good road links along the Main A40 from Fishguard to Haverfordwest and Carmarthen and the M4 to Cardiff and London as well as good rail links from both Fishguard and Haverfordwest to Carmarthen, Cardiff, London Paddington and the rest of the UK.

Trellwyn Fach stands on the hillside adjacent to Dinas

Mountain and is situated within the Pembrokeshire Coast National Park.

## Directions

From Fishguard take the B4313 road south east in the direction of Maenclochog for 2 miles and in the village of Llanychaer, take the turning on the left opposite the Bridge End Public House, signposted to Dinas. Continue on this road and proceed over the bridge and up the hill for in excess of half a mile and take the first turning on the right towards Dinas Mountain. Continue on this road for a mile or so and you will reach the first farm on the right hand side of the road known as Trellwyn Fawr . A hardsurfaced track of approximately Two Thirds of a mile leads down to the Property.

Alternatively from Fishguard take the Main A487 road east for some 3 miles towards Cardigan and take the turning on the right, signposted to Llanychaer. Continue on this road for a mile and a half or so and take the first turning on the left (pposite Llanllawer Church) towards Dinas Mountain. Continue on this road for a mile or so and take the first turning on the right into Trellwyn Fawr and a hardsurfaced track leads down to the Property.

## Description

Trellwyn Fach is a 146 Acre Stock Farm which stands on the hillside adjacent to Dinas Mountain. A predominantly hardsurfaced track of approximately Two Thirds of a mile leads down to the farmstead where there is a Derelict Stone Farmhouse together with a range of Traditional Stone Outbuildings which are in need of renovation.

The Land in total extends to 145.854 Acres or thereabouts of which there is approximately 90 Acres of clean predominantly gently sloping pasture land. The remaining 55 Acres or thereabouts of either rough grazing land, wet land, scrub and a small area of woodland. The land is in the main sheep fenced and benefits from good natural water supplies, which are in the main on the south eastern boundaries.

water from a nearby stream. There is no Mains Water in the vicinity of the Property, although there is ample natural water on the land and the hillside adjacent to Dinas Mountain.

### Rights of Ways

Access Rights of Ways exist in favour of the Property over the Access Lane and Farmyard that is part of Trellwyn Fawr, Dinas Cross.

N.B. The owner of Trellwyn Fawr would be prepared to consider granting a new access Right of Way in favour of the purchaser of Trellwyn Fach, over a hardsurfaced track that is owned by Trellwyn Fawr and leading off the Council Road, which would avoid travelling through the Farmyard at Trellwyn Fawr.

### Common Grazing Rights

Trellwyn Fach is entitled to graze 248 Sheep, 29 Cattle and 10 Ponies on Mynydd Dinas. Registration Unit Nos C.L. 20, C.L. 177.


### Remarks




