



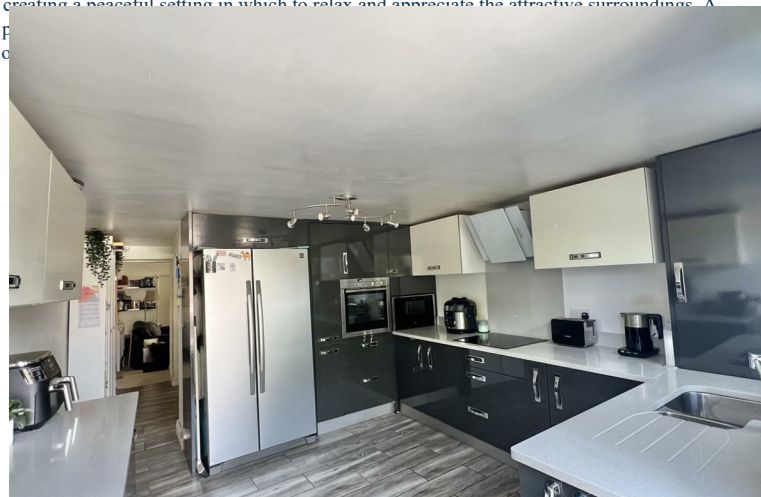
18 HIGH GREEN, GAINFORD, DARLINGTON, DL2 3DL

Deceptively spacious throughout, this charming home seamlessly blends period features with modern comforts. To the rear is a private enclosed garden, bordered by an original stone wall that provides both character and privacy, together with a useful garden shed and gated side access. Please note that neighbouring properties benefit from a right of way across the rear for pedestrian access, including the movement of bins.

Stepping inside, the welcoming entrance hallway immediately showcases the property's heritage, with an impressive original 19th-century wooden staircase providing a striking focal point. To the front, the elegant sitting room enjoys uninterrupted views across the village green, creating a peaceful setting in which to relax and appreciate the attractive surroundings. A



The first floor continues to impress with a generous principal bedroom positioned to the front of the property, featuring a beautiful bay window that frames delightful views over the village green. Two further well-proportioned bedrooms are situated to the rear, while the stylish family bathroom has been thoughtfully appointed with a luxurious freestanding bath, a walk-in shower enclosure, wash hand basin with vanity storage and a WC.

Gainford remains one of County Durham's most desirable villages, offering an excellent range of local amenities, a welcoming community and outstanding countryside on the doorstep. The beautiful banks of the River Tees are within easy reach, providing scenic riverside walks and opportunities to enjoy the surrounding natural landscape. The historic Gainford Spa, whose Victorian mineral spring first brought fame to the village, remains a fascinating reminder of its celebrated past, while excellent transport links and nearby Darlington provide convenient access for commuters. Combining a wealth of history, period charm and an enviable village setting, this is a wonderful opportunity to acquire a home of genuine character in one of the area's most sought-after locations.

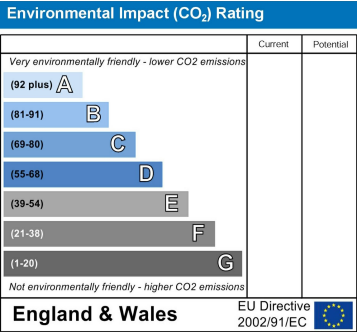
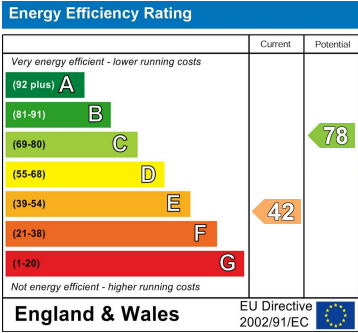
