

Haere-Mai presents a rare and compelling opportunity to secure an enviable slice of the Gower coast, just moments from the unspoilt sands of Slade Bay. Set in an elevated position and enveloped by mature gardens, this wonderfully private property offers peace, seclusion, and captivating sea views—a perfect canvas for a coastal retreat.

Occupying a generous 0.42-acre plot, the existing residence extends to approximately 1,988 sq ft and is arranged primarily above a substantial double garage/workshop. The current layout includes three bedrooms, two reception rooms, and a striking south-facing sun terrace that looks out to sea—an ideal vantage point for watching the sun trace its arc across the horizon.

While the house now requires modernisation, its scale, setting, and orientation offer enormous scope—whether through sensitive refurbishment or a bold new build project (subject to planning). The surroundings are serene and lush, with the garden offering both structure and potential, perfectly complementing the property's coastal charm.

Haere-Mai is a property for visionaries—an inspiring and increasingly rare chance to reimagine a home in one of the most sought-after and spectacular corners of the Gower Peninsula. 
