The accommodation is thoughtfully arranged over two levels. The heart of the home is the superb open-plan kitchen, dining and living space positioned across the rear of the entrance level. Flooded with natural light from rooflights and glazed doors opening directly onto the garden, this is a wonderfully sociable and characterful space. The kitchen is well appointed with ample work surfaces and storage, while the living area centres around a wood-burning stove, creating a warm and inviting focal point.

Also on the ground floor are two well-proportioned bedrooms situated off the main hallway. A generous double bedroom is positioned to the front, while a versatile additional room, ideal as a home office or third bedroom, sits alongside. A contemporary shower room serves this level.


Stairs lead down to the lower ground floor, where a further double bedroom benefits from its own en-suite bathroom, creating an ideal guest suite or private principal retreat.
