About The Property

This is a well-appointed three-bedroom semi-detached house located on the north side of the city, near Old Sarum. The property features a spacious entrance hall and a downstairs cloakroom. The fully fitted kitchen/breakfast room includes a high-quality range of units, featuring a gas hob, a single electric oven, an integral fridge and freezer, as well as an integral dishwasher and washing machine. French doors lead out to the garden.

The full-length sitting room also has doors that open to the garden. Additionally, there is a study. On the first floor, you will find three good-sized bedrooms, two of which are doubles.
