About The Property

One of the nicest Town Houses you will ever see! Two period houses over three floors, dating from 1790, that have now been converted into one home together with extensions to the rear offering a wonderful balance of contemporary and character features. There are exposed timbers throughout, a fireplace with woodburning stove, exposed brickwork and bifold doors from the kitchen. The home office/downstairs bedroom (which also has its own separate access) with shower room, could be utilised as a separate annex to include the breakfast room. The current owners have previously used this as an Air BnB, with income potential circa £1000 pcm. There is the residue of a garage for storage and the river runs at the end of the garden. Considerable attention has been paid to the detail and recent building works include damp proofing, wiring and boiler replacement. It is offered in really exceptional condition and we can only suggest that an early visit is really essential to appreciate!

The solid wood front door leads into the dining room which has stairs to the first floor with storage area beneath. A central fireplace has access on both sides to the double length sitting room with door to garden, fireplace and wood burning stove. Both reception rooms have an abundance of exposed timbers and brickwork. The 24 foot long Kitchen has been recently refitted with a terrific range of work surfaces with matching base and wall mounted cupboards and drawers, built in appliances, island and breakfast bar. Large bifold doors open the room into the garden and create wonderful entertaining space. Beyond the kitchen there is a breakfast room with doors to the garden. A door leads through to the study/bedroom 3 which has it's own shower room and from here a door leads to the residue garage/ workshop which offers very useful storage and wheelie bin space and doors onto North Street.

On the first floor are two bedrooms, one with vaulted ceiling, and a bathroom. Wooden loft ladders give access to two further rooms which could be used as occasional bedrooms.

To the rear is a lovely walled garden with sitting areas, mature shrubs and trees. Lawn leads down to a covered sitting area which then has steps and wrought iron gate giving access to a tributary of the River Wylye.
