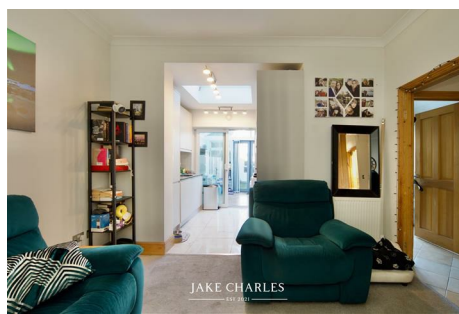

A standout feature is the refurbished outhouse at the rear of the garden, complete with electricity and internet access - ideal for use as a home office, studio, or additional storage.

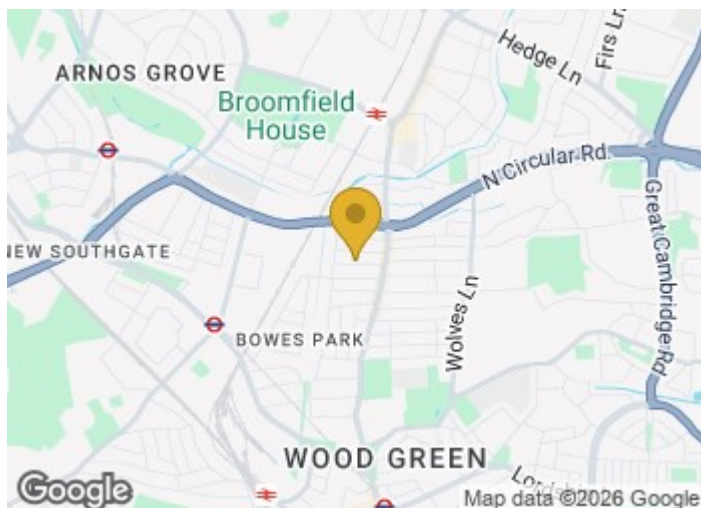

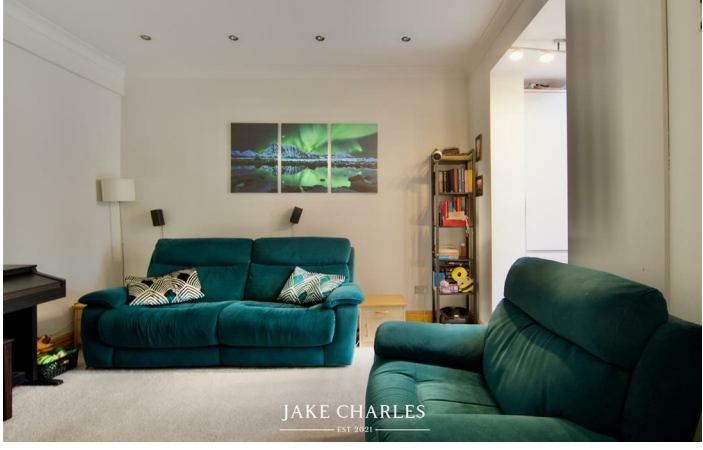

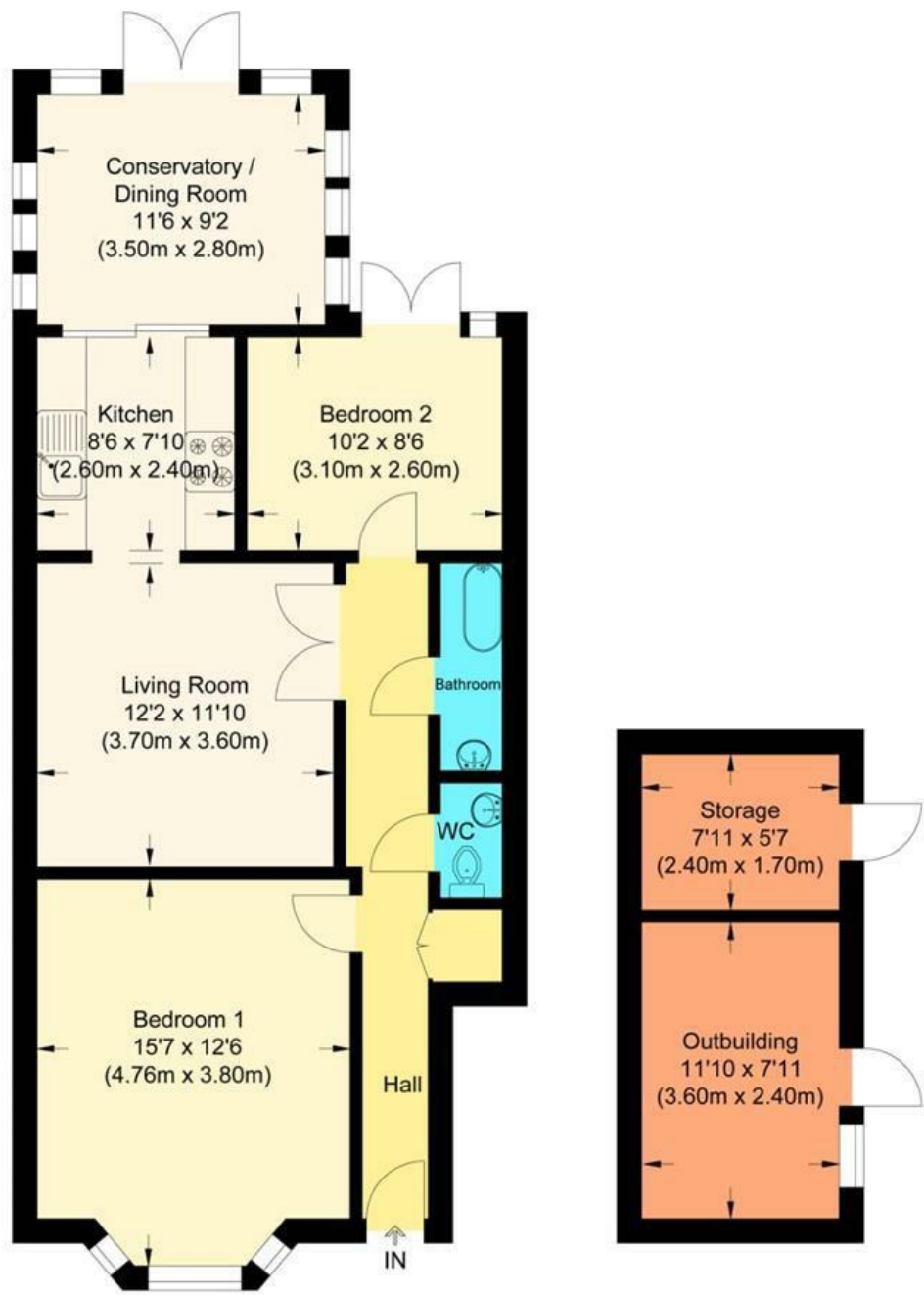
