Living room

Accessed from the hallway, a lovely 21 ft room with plenty of natural light from two tall windows and a view of the garden. The room also benefits with a large open fireplace to enjoy during the colder evenings.

Sitting room

A further reception room with dual aspect windows, plenty of natural light and a door to the garden. The room also benefits with an open fireplace.

Kitchen

At the front of the house, a more modern room, with plenty of storage cupboards, double oven and induction hob. The kitchen also benefits with a utility/pantry room with a window, a perfect storage space. There is a door to the front, so you can bring your shopping straight into the kitchen for ease.

Dining room

A lovely space for an eight seater table, storage units and an original old stove.

Master bedroom

At the rear of the property with fitted wardrobes and dual aspect windows, plenty of natural light and benefits with a lovely view of the garden.

Bedroom 2

At the rear of the property with fitted wardrobe/storage space on either side of the chimney. A great size double room.

Bedroom 3

At the front of the property, a further double with storage on either side of the chimney.

Family Bathroom

A great size dual aspect bathroom with bath, WC and wash hand basin. There is an opportunity to split in two due to the shape and size of the bathroom.



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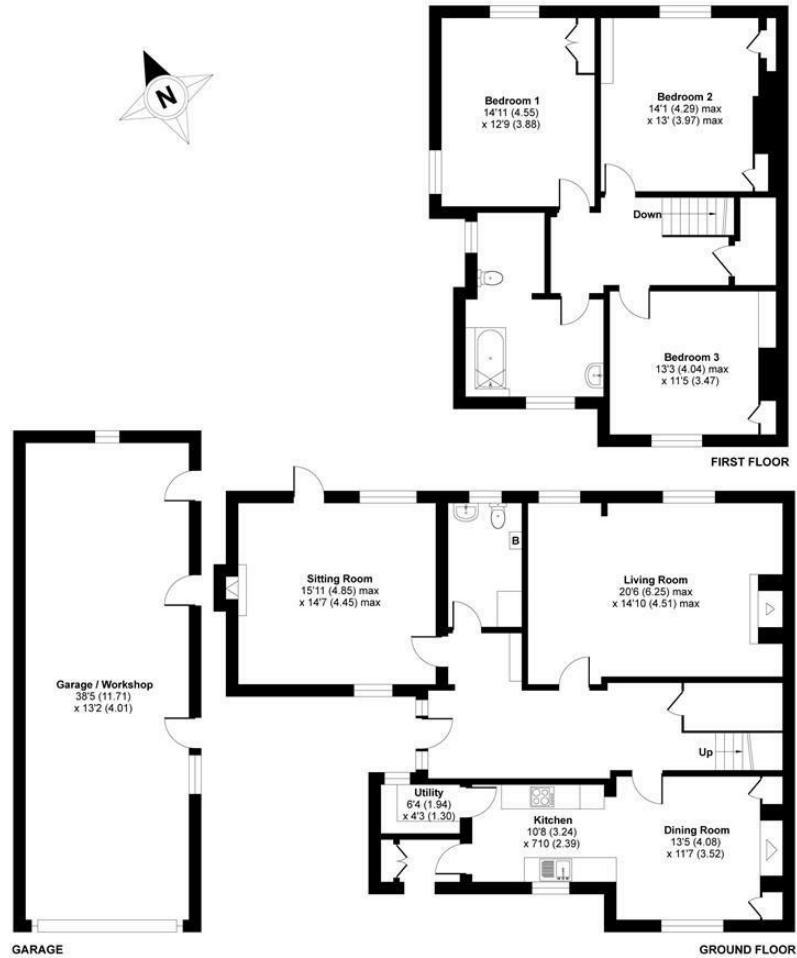
