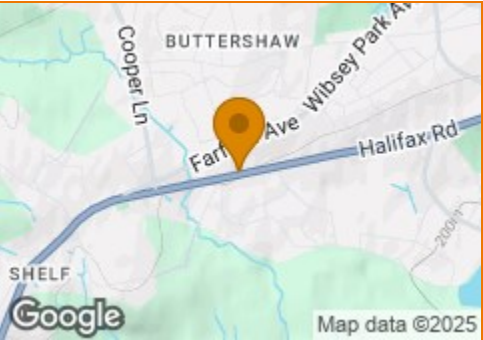


Terrain Map

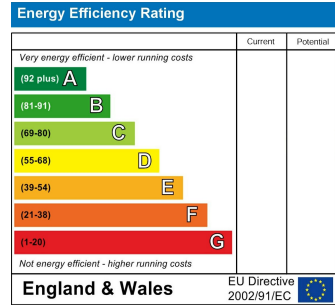

Located in a most prominent position on a main arterial road in an area surrounded by both commercial and residential properties and suitable for a variety of potential uses subject to works and the appropriate consents. A detached building mainly stone built and having a car park at the rear.
