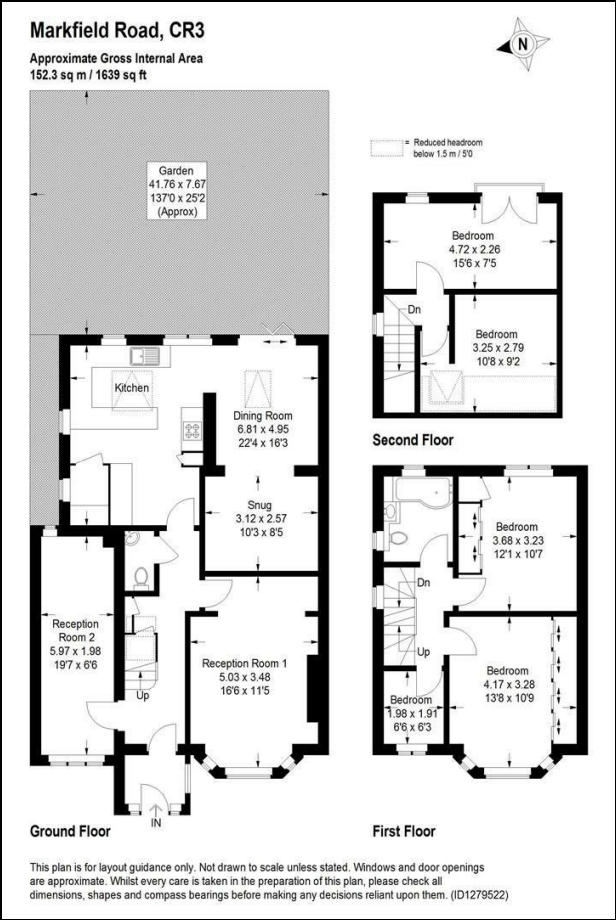
Accommodation
