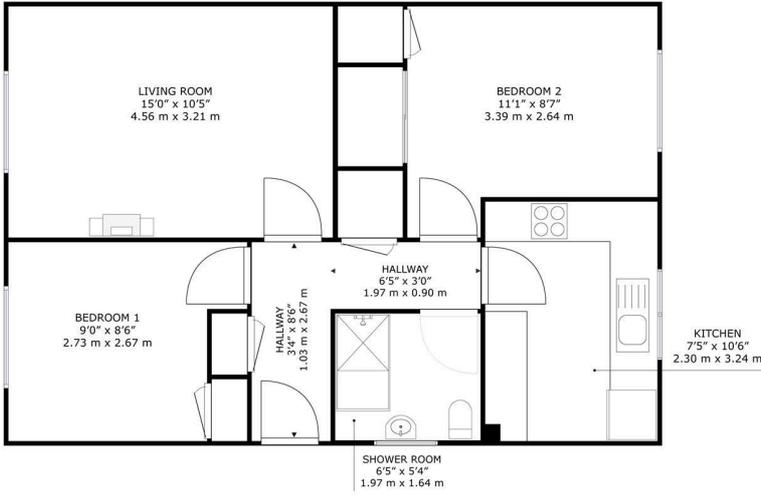
Heating is via electric storage and panel heaters and the windows are double glazed throughout.
