



12 Barossa Place, Perth, PH1 5HH Offers Over £348,000










The property boasts spacious accommodation over two floors including 4/5 bedrooms, 2/3 reception rooms, bathroom and shower room. The patio doors from the reception/bedroom on the ground floor leads out to the low maintenance rear garden area. The accommodation on the first floor boasts four large bedrooms and a shower room providing ample space for a family of all ages.


The property has many original period features with ornate coving, ceiling rose and working fireplaces. Heating is provided by a gas fired heating system and the property benefits from double and secondary glazing.

The rear of the property can be accessed either via the utility room or from the downstairs reception/bedroom to the rear. The rear garden is a good sized low maintenance area featuring external brick built storage, a slabbed patio and a varity of small shrubs and plants.

Location: This property could not be better situated for its locality to nearby amenities including businesses and shopping found in the city centre. Barossa Place is within a short walking distance of the Perth Theatre, Concert Hall and Museum. The North Inch Parklands with sports and leisure facilities and picturesque River Tay are only a few steps away from the property.
