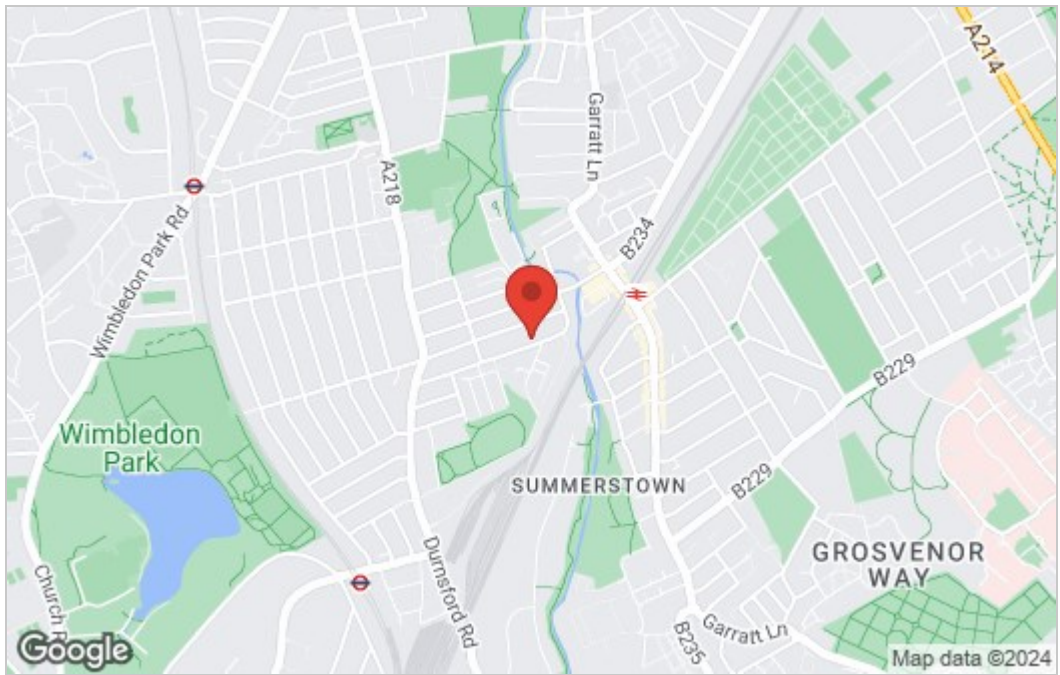
The first floor offers two double bedrooms, a single bedroom and a family bathroom. The second floor has a spacious and light double bedroom with an en-suite bathroom.
