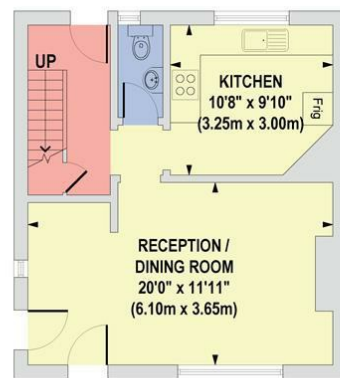
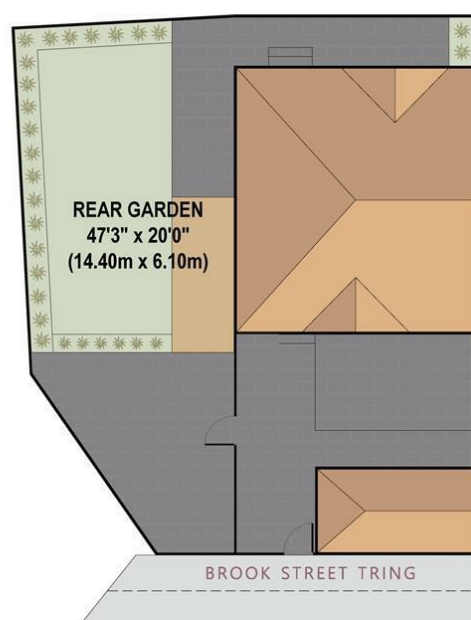

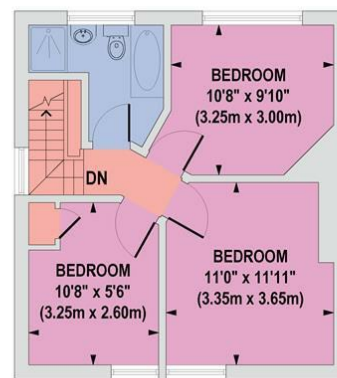

Approximate Gross Internal Floor Area

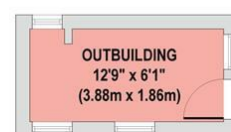

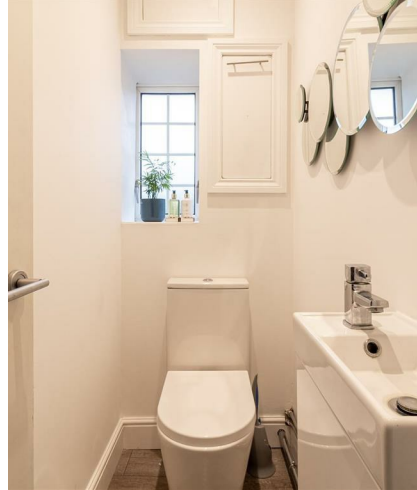

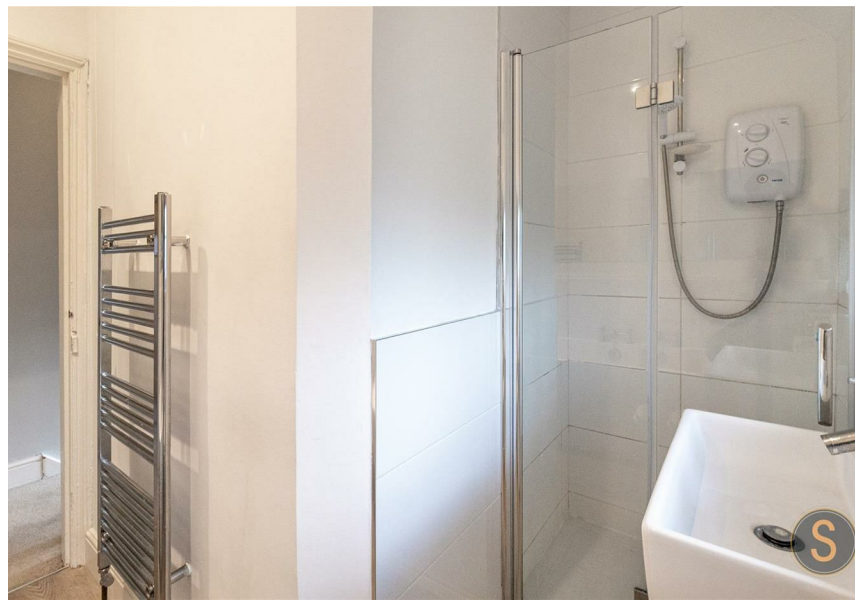

Ground Floor

A front door leads you into the semi open plan living space which is split into a dining area which has a glass door opening to the side where there is also a window. Moving through the property to the living room there is a window to the front and a chimney breast with feature alcove with shelving fitted to both sides. A door leads to an inner lobby where there are stairs rising to the first floor doors opening to the cloakroom and kitchen and a door to the rear. The kitchen is fitted with a range of base and eye level units and is large enough to accommodate a breakfast table and chairs.

First Floor

A landing has doors opening to all first floor bedrooms. The principal bedroom has a window to the front and boasts a range of fitted wardrobes with ample hanging and storage space. The second bedroom overlooks the rear and the third bedroom overlooks the front. The spacious family bathroom is fitted with a white four piece suite comprising panelled bath, separate shower, wash basin and low level wc.

Outside

The property is enclosed with fencing with a pedestrian gate opening to a lovely front courtyard where a door opens to a useful outhouse with power and light making it versatile for a variety of uses. For instance a treatment room, gym or home office. The rear garden has an area laid to hardstanding and a timber decked area. The main part of the garden is laid to lawn and is exceptionally well screened by a mature hedgerow.

The Location

Tring is a pretty market town on the edge of the Chiltern Hills, mentioned in 1086 in the Domesday book. The town offers a wide range of recreational facilities, including a branch of the Natural History Museum, the Grand Union Canal, Pendley Court Theatre, and various sporting activities. Local shopping facilities are varied and include a selection of independent boutiques, plus larger chains such as Tesco and M&S Simply Food. There are also a number of restaurants and cafes, including Costa and Black Goo.

On Your Doorstep

The slightly larger market town of Berkhamsted is only around 5 miles away, and offers a further range of shops and facilities, including Waitrose and Starbucks. Buckinghamshire's County Town, Aylesbury, is around 8 miles and boasts a multiplex cinema, shopping centres, and a recently completed £42 million theatre.

Education In The Area

The area boasts some excellent educational facilities, including Tring School. For those wishing to use the independent sector, Tring Park School for the Performing Arts, Berkhamsted School, and Chesham Preparatory School all have superb reputations. This property is also within easy striking distance of the Ofsted outstanding Goldfield Primary school and Bishopswood Junior School.

Transport Links

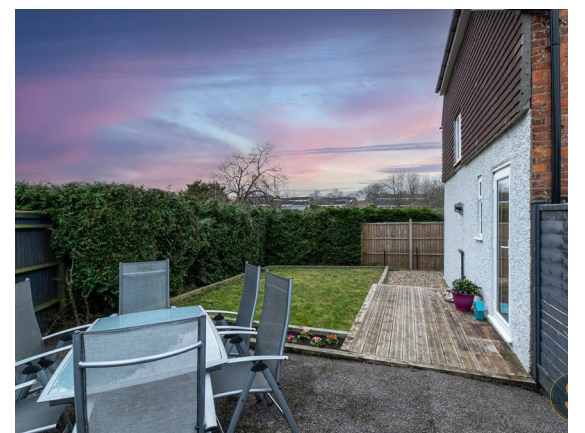
