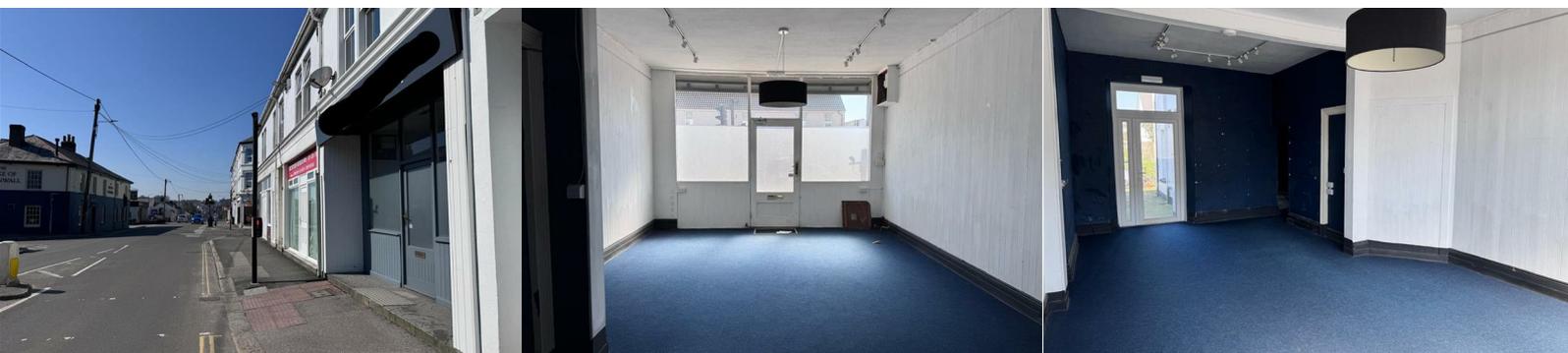

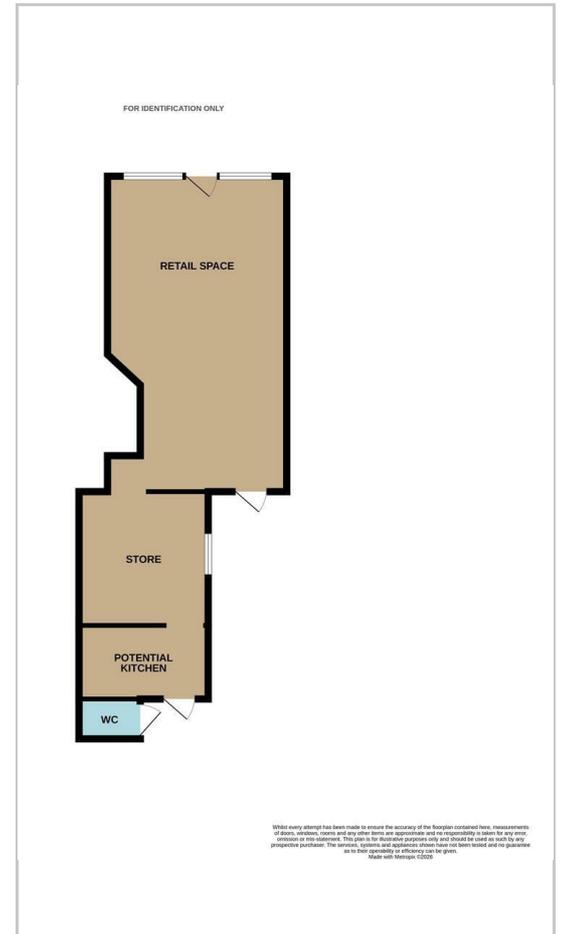

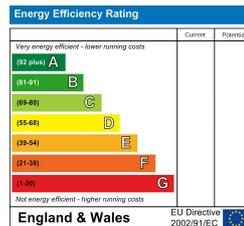
Area Map
