Garage in nearby block

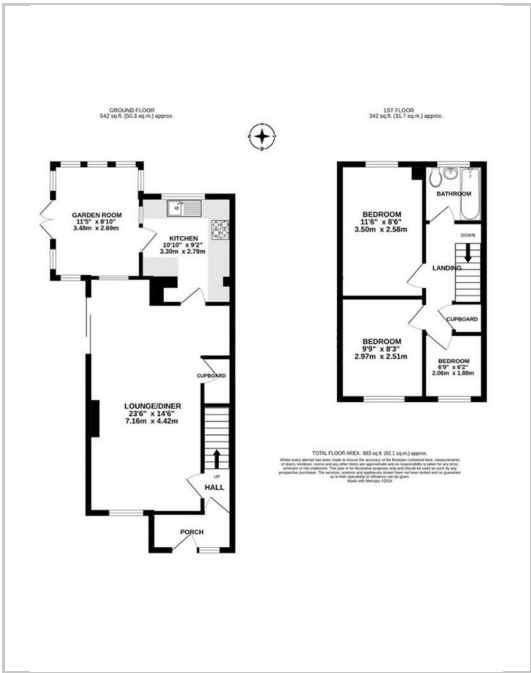

Wallingford is located within easy access to the M4, M40 and A34, Harwell campus and mainline stations can be found at nearby Cholsey and Didcot.

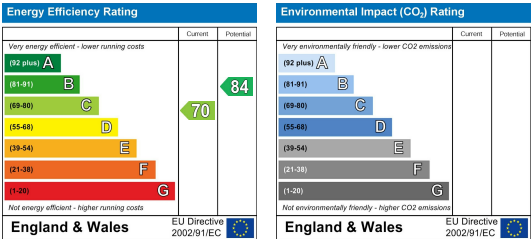
Area Map
