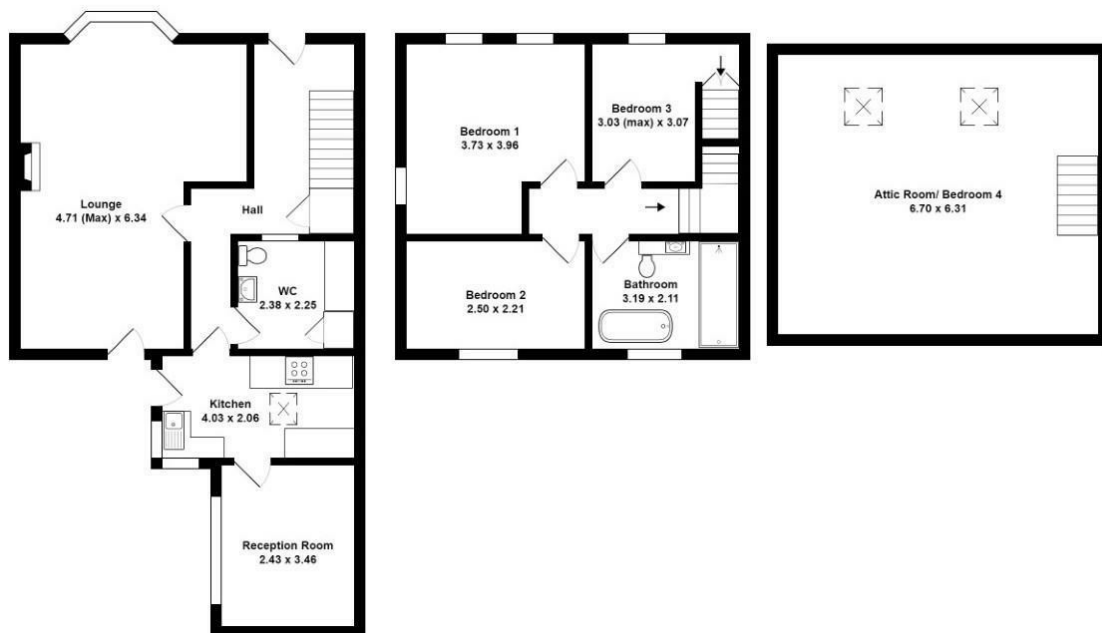

DIRECTIONS

From Penzance proceed in an easterly direction on the A30 and take the A3094 toward Helston. At the mini roundabout take the first exit toward Goldsithney following the road into the village. Trelawney House is situated on the left hand side of the road prior to the traffic calming scheme.

Goldsithney (in Cornish Golsydhni - meaning Fair of St Sithney) is a sought after village approximately five miles east of Penzance with a village shop, 2 public houses, and primary schooling in the neighbouring village of St. Hilary. A bus service to Marazion just over a mile away provides access to the sandy beach and St. Michaels Mount. The larger town of Penzance offers a range of facilities, further schooling and a myriad of independent shops. Transport links from Penzance railway and bus station provide services to the rest of the country.
