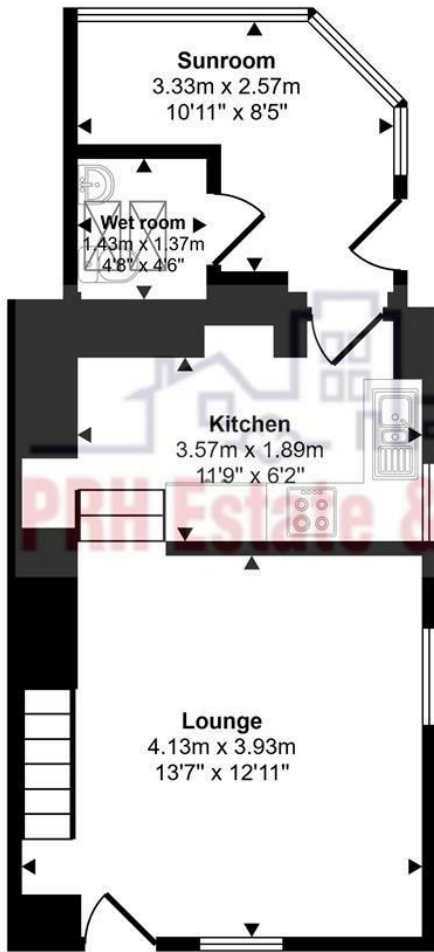
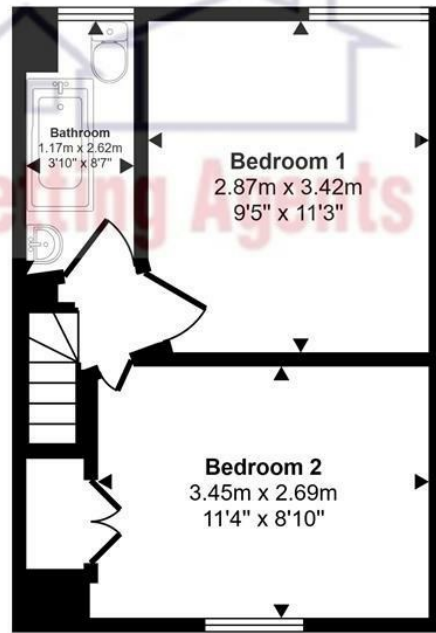

DIRECTIONS

Upon entering Marazion from the Penzance direction, continue passing the square and market place. Shortly after the second church the property is located on the right hand side of the road taking the corner of Fore Street and Oates Road.

Marazion is one of Cornwall's most sought-after coastal towns, famously home to St Michael's Mount. The town offers a vibrant community with independent galleries, cafes, and restaurants. Located just 3 miles from Penzance, the town enjoys easy access to a wider range of amenities, including major supermarkets and the mainline railway station with direct links to London Paddington.
