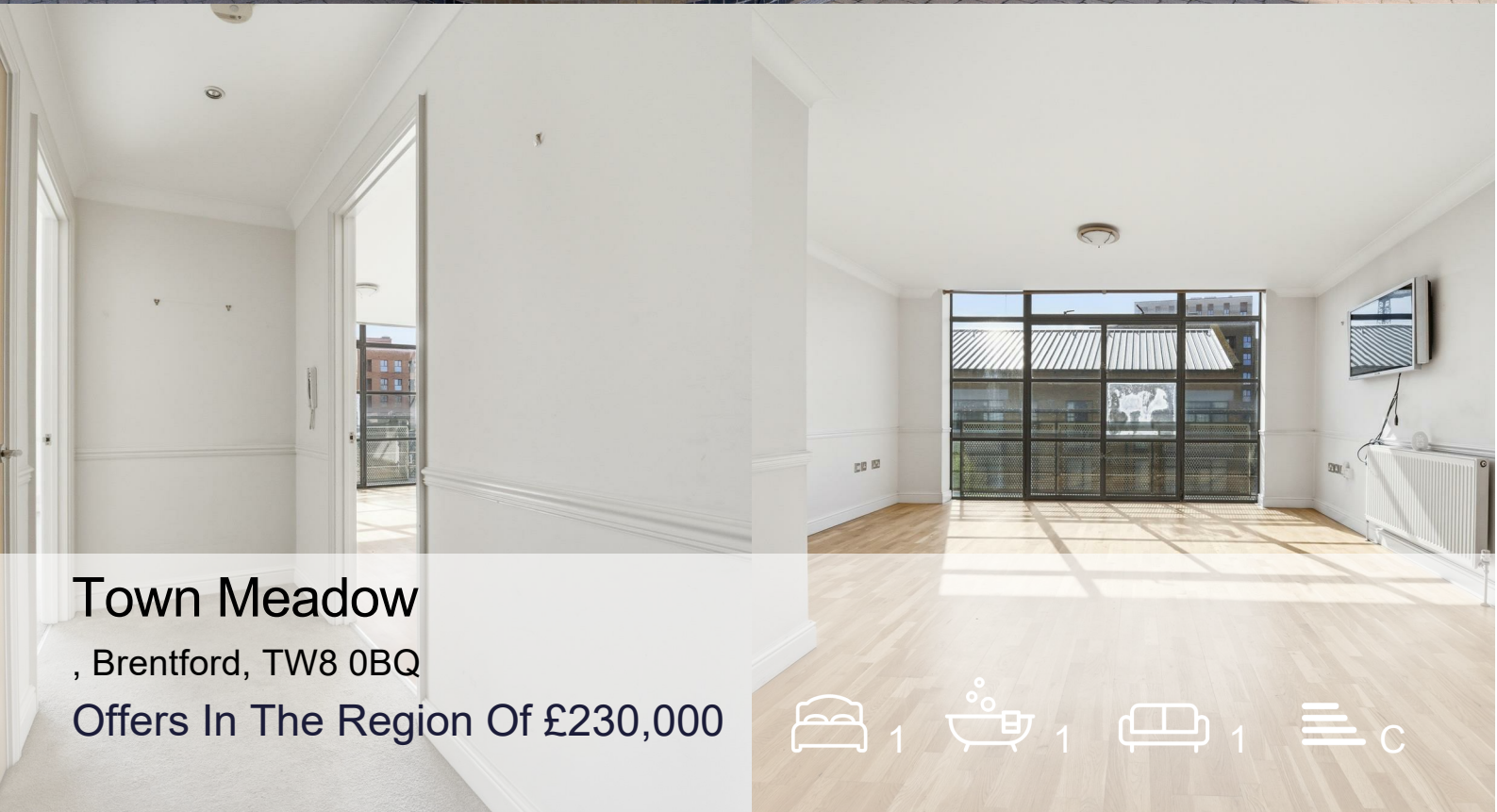

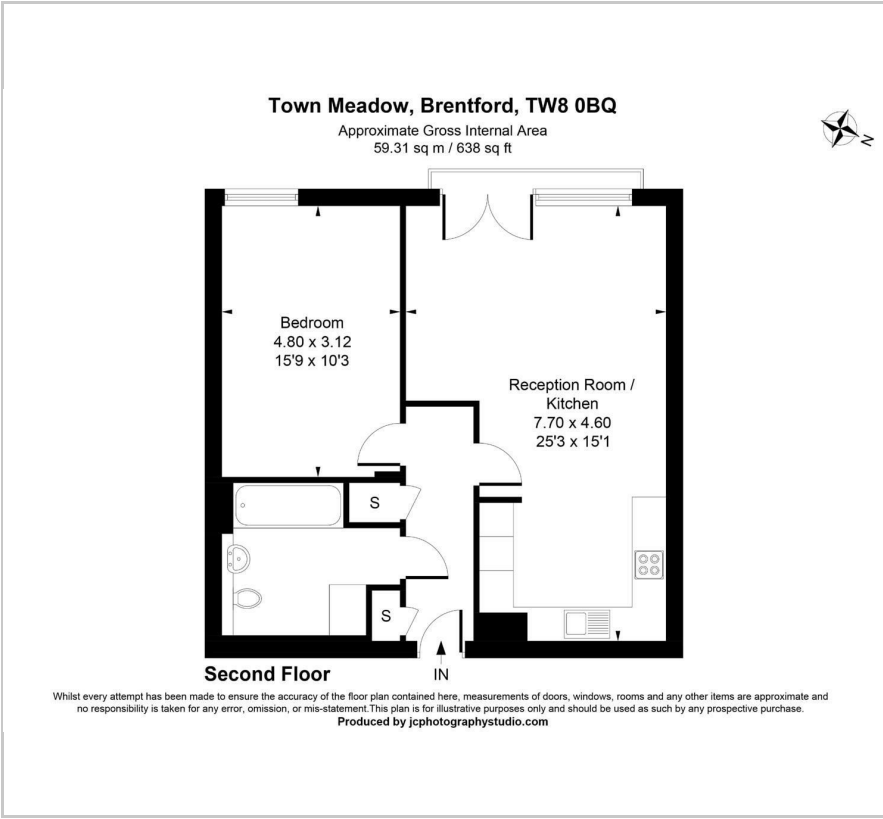

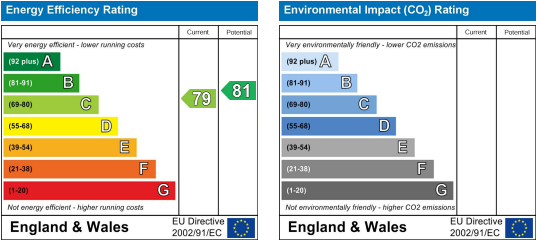
Floor Plan
