### **Ground Floor Flat - 59a Liberty Road**

The ground floor flat benefits from electric heating and all windows are UPVC double glazed. There is a communal entrance hall with fire door leading into the apartment. There is a lounge with two windows including a bay to the side, fitted kitchen with oven/hob, good sized double bedroom & a shower room with 3 piece suite. There is a garden to front and a driveway & clothes drying area to side. See floorplan for measurements.

### **First Floor Flat - 59b Liberty Road**

The first floor flat benefits from electric heating and all windows are UPVC double glazed. There is a communal entrance hall with fire door leading to stairs up to the apartment. There is a lounge with two windows, fitted kitchen with oven/hob, good sized double bedroom & a bathroom with 3 piece suite. There is a garden to front and a driveway & clothes drying area to side. ### **Glenfield**

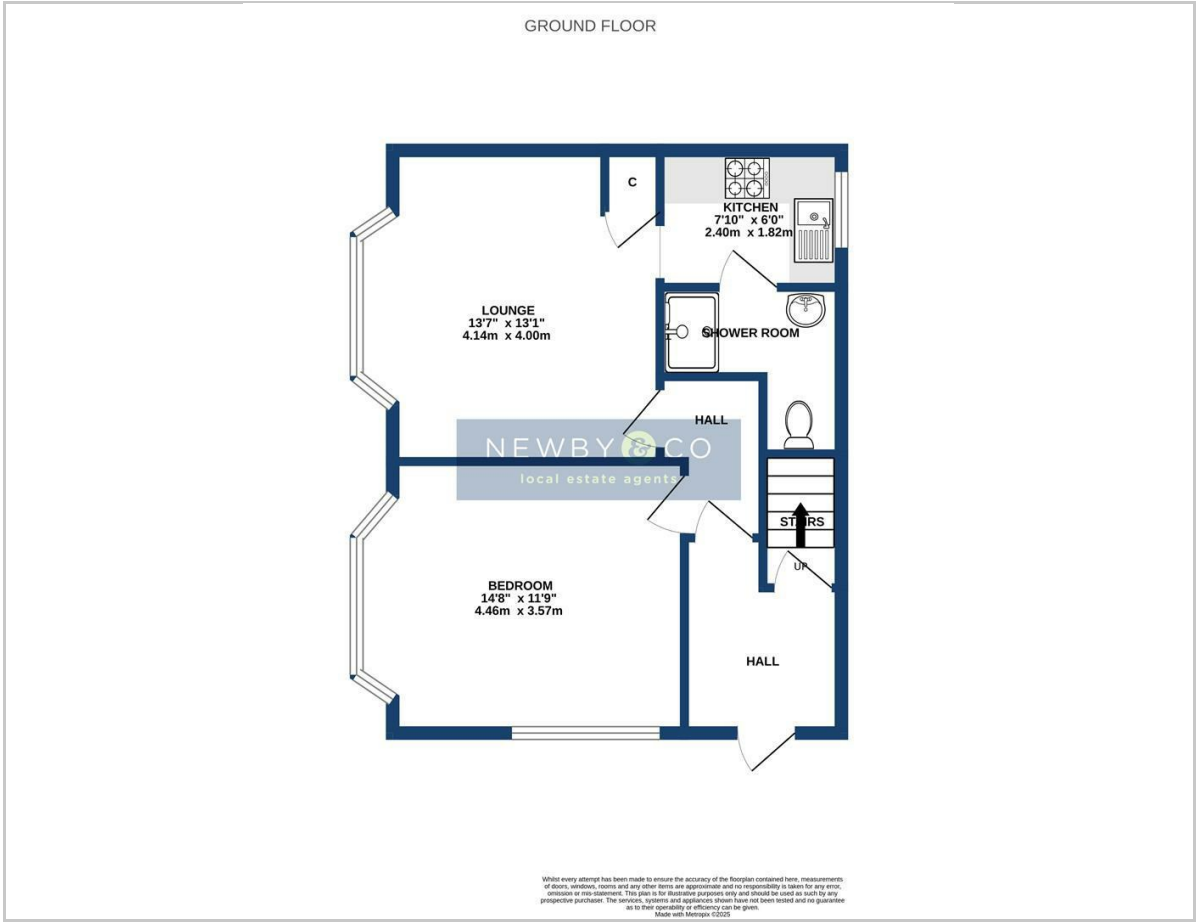
Glenfield is a popular large village 5 miles to the West of Leicester city centre with a population of approx 9,500. There are two well regarded primary schools, three pubs, St Peters church and a range of local shopping facilities including a relatively new Morrison's store on Station Road. There is nearby open countryside including Bradgate Park and Gynsills conservation area. There is easy access to M1, A46 & A50 main routes. Glenfield General Hospital & Leics County Council are two large employers. Glenfield is mentioned in the Domesday book of 1086 and is also famous for its now defunct railway tunnel built by Stevenson and once the longest in the world. Regular bus services into Leicester serve the village and Leicester train station is approx 5 miles away.
