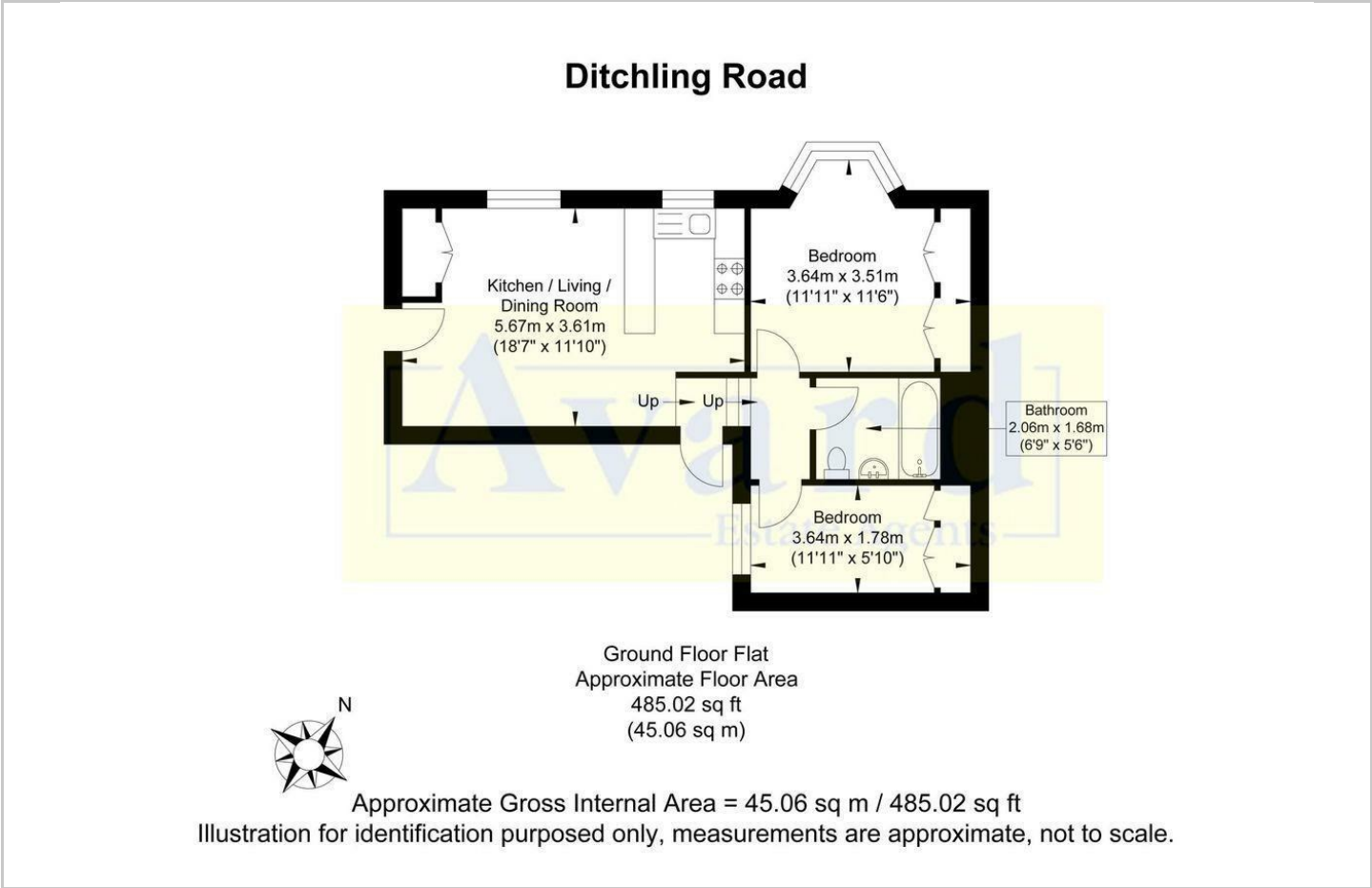

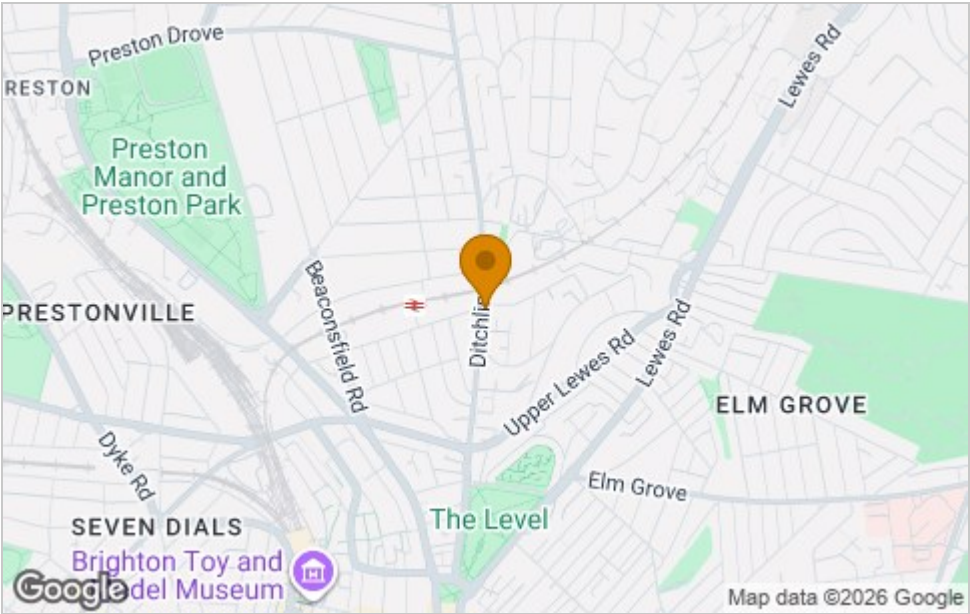




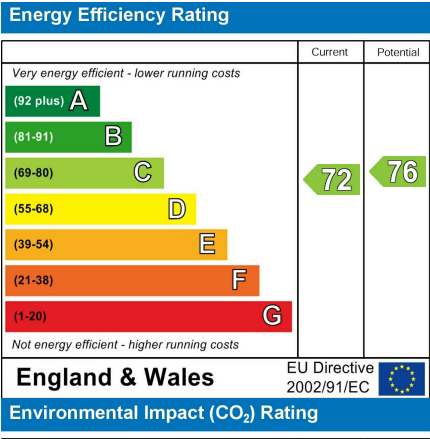
Floor Plan
