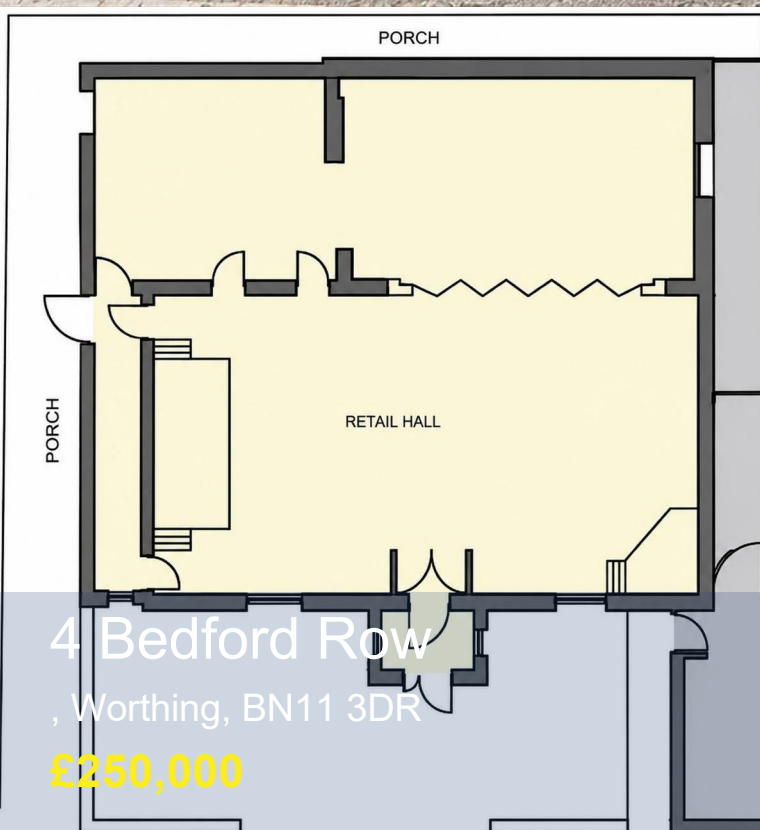
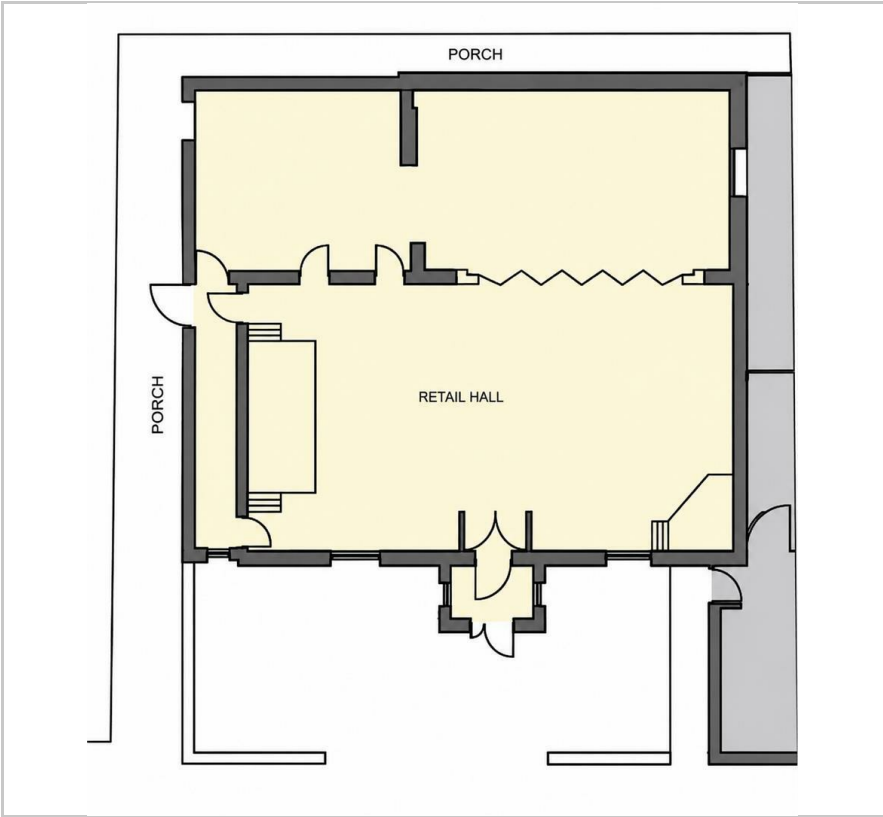




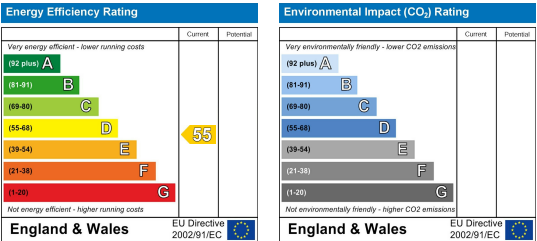
Floor Plan
