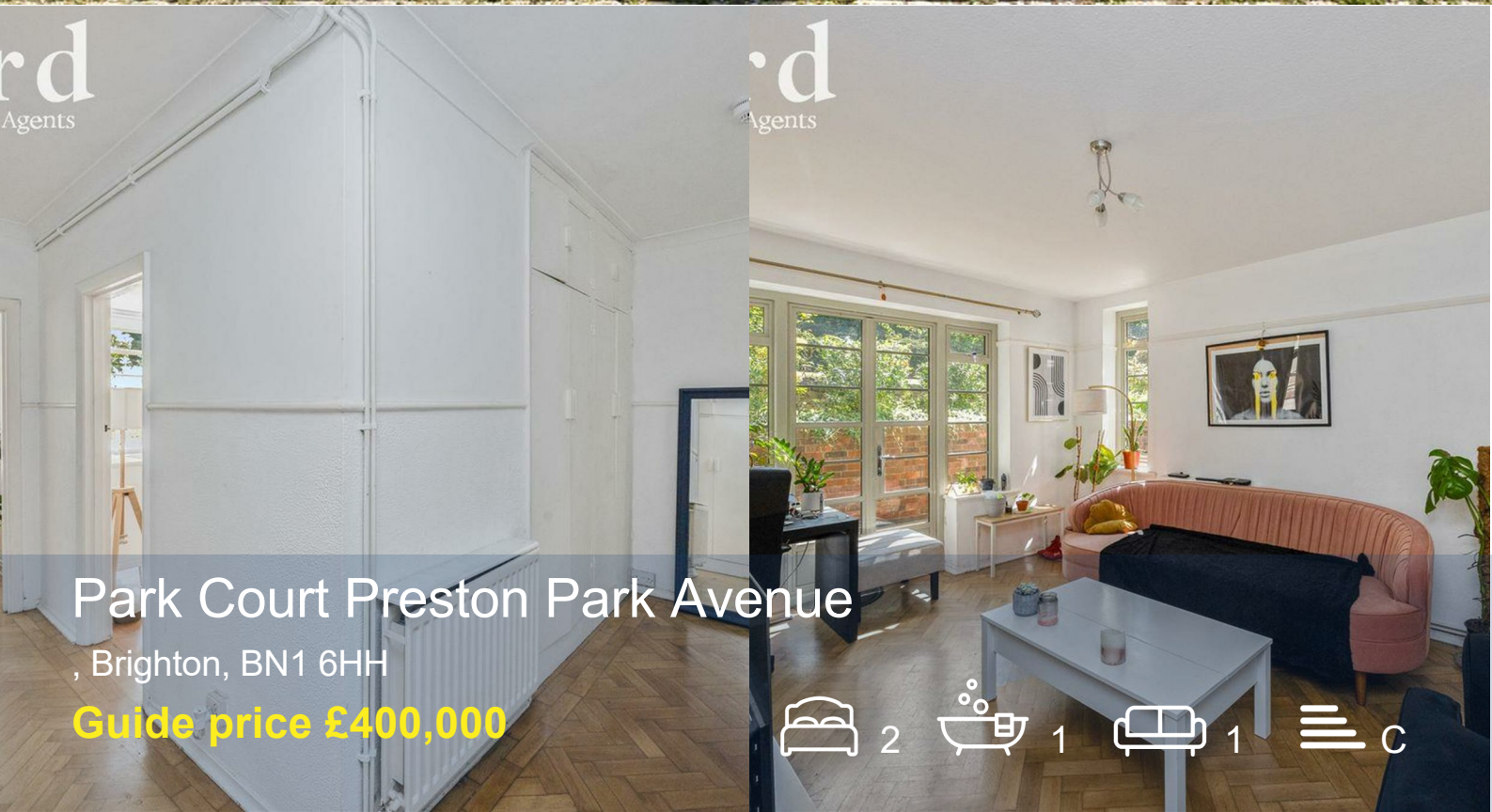


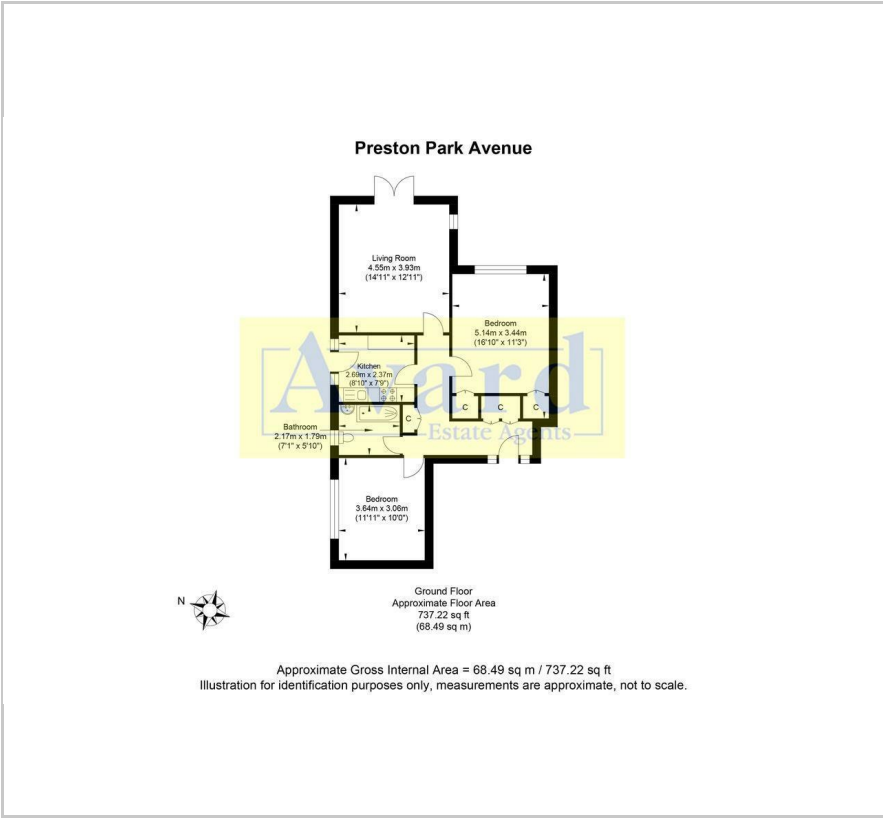

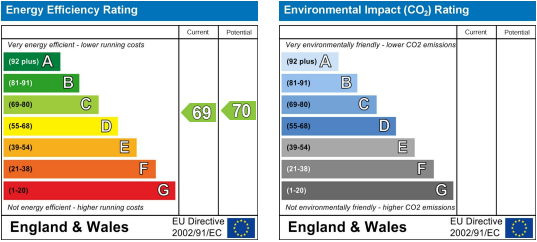
Floor Plan
