Highlights include a farmhouse-style kitchen with vaulted ceiling and skylights, a welcoming lounge with exposed beams, and a private, low-maintenance garden—just moments from the heart of picturesque Wymeswold.



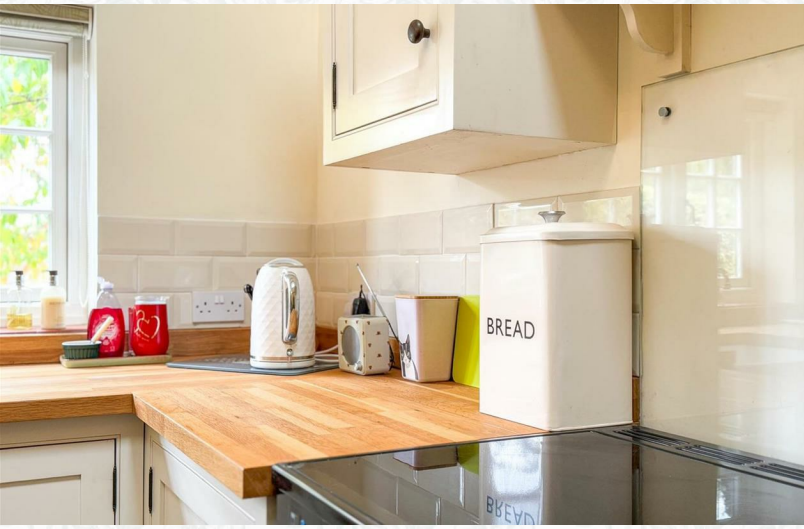
Beyond the wooden gate, a gravel path winds through the cottage's charming front garden to a sheltered porch and front door. Inside, the entrance hall instantly sets the tone with stone-tiled flooring, a feature brick fireplace with log burner, exposed beams, and shuttered windows overlooking the garden. This room is wonderfully versatile—it could easily serve as an additional sitting area or dining space. To the left, the farmhouse-style kitchen exudes rustic charm with a vaulted ceiling and Velux skylights that flood the room with light. Bespoke cabinetry, solid wood work surfaces, and a Belfast sink complete the country aesthetic, complemented by integrated appliances including a dishwasher, and space for a range cooker and fridge-freezer. There's also room for a small dining table, making it a warm, social space for everyday living.







From the hall, a small connecting room with matching stone-tiled floors leads to the lounge—an intimate, relaxing space perfect for quiet evenings. This area features exposed beams, a character chimney breast with fireplace, and newly fitted laminate flooring. The connecting room also offers excellent practicality, with two storage cupboards—one housing the washing machine—making it ideal as a home office, laundry, or craft space.





Upstairs, the master bedroom offers a tranquil retreat, with soft carpeting, tasteful décor, and space for a king-size bed and additional furniture. A window frames a serene outlook across the curtain of willow trees lining the brook beyond. The family bathroom, positioned between the two bedrooms, features a three-piece suite with shower-over-bath, subway tiling, tiled floors, a heated towel rail, and privacy glass window. Bedroom two is another comfortable double, with painted floorboards, neutral tones, and a handy built-in storage cupboard under the eaves—ideal for guests or as a stylish home office.





Outside, the front garden has been thoughtfully landscaped for privacy and low maintenance. A gravelled area is bordered by mature shrubs and colourful flowerbeds, while a stunning passion flower drapes over a timber archway. A granite-set patio provides a perfect spot to unwind with a glass of wine on a summer's evening. There's also a practical storage shed and ample parking on the driveway for two vehicles.



Wymeswold is one of Leicestershire's most sought-after villages, known for its warm community feel, picturesque surroundings, and excellent amenities. The village boasts two popular pubs, a well-regarded primary school, farm shop, and tearoom, along with beautiful countryside walks right on the doorstep. 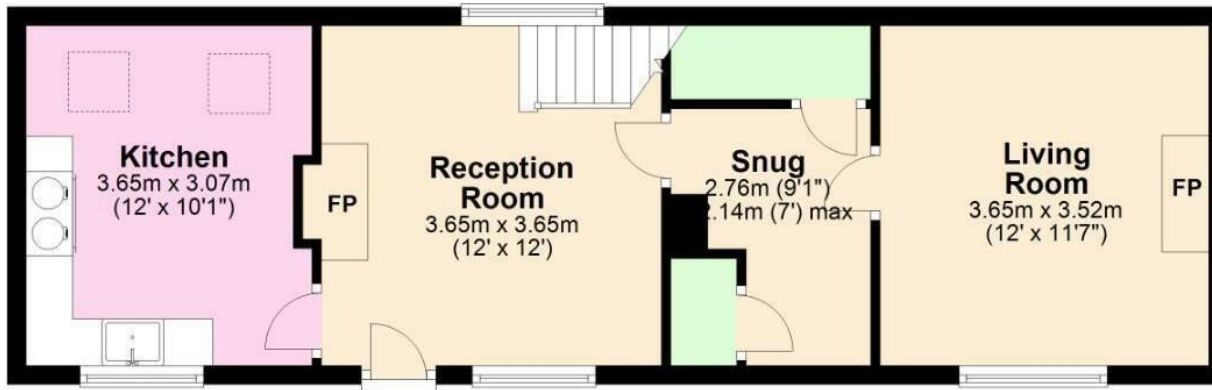

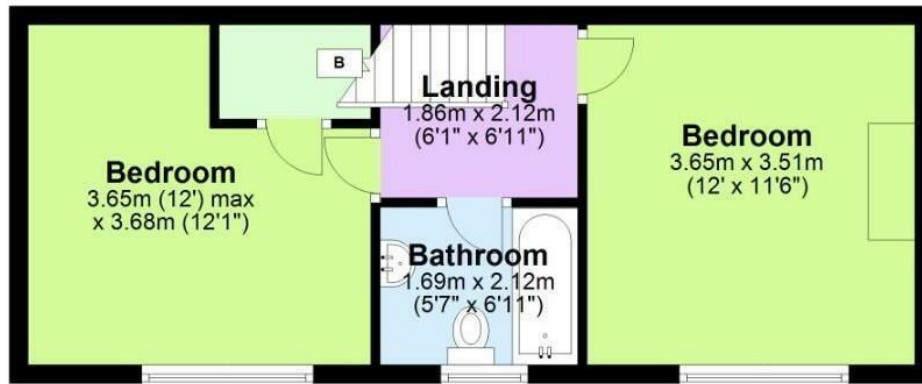
Ground Floor

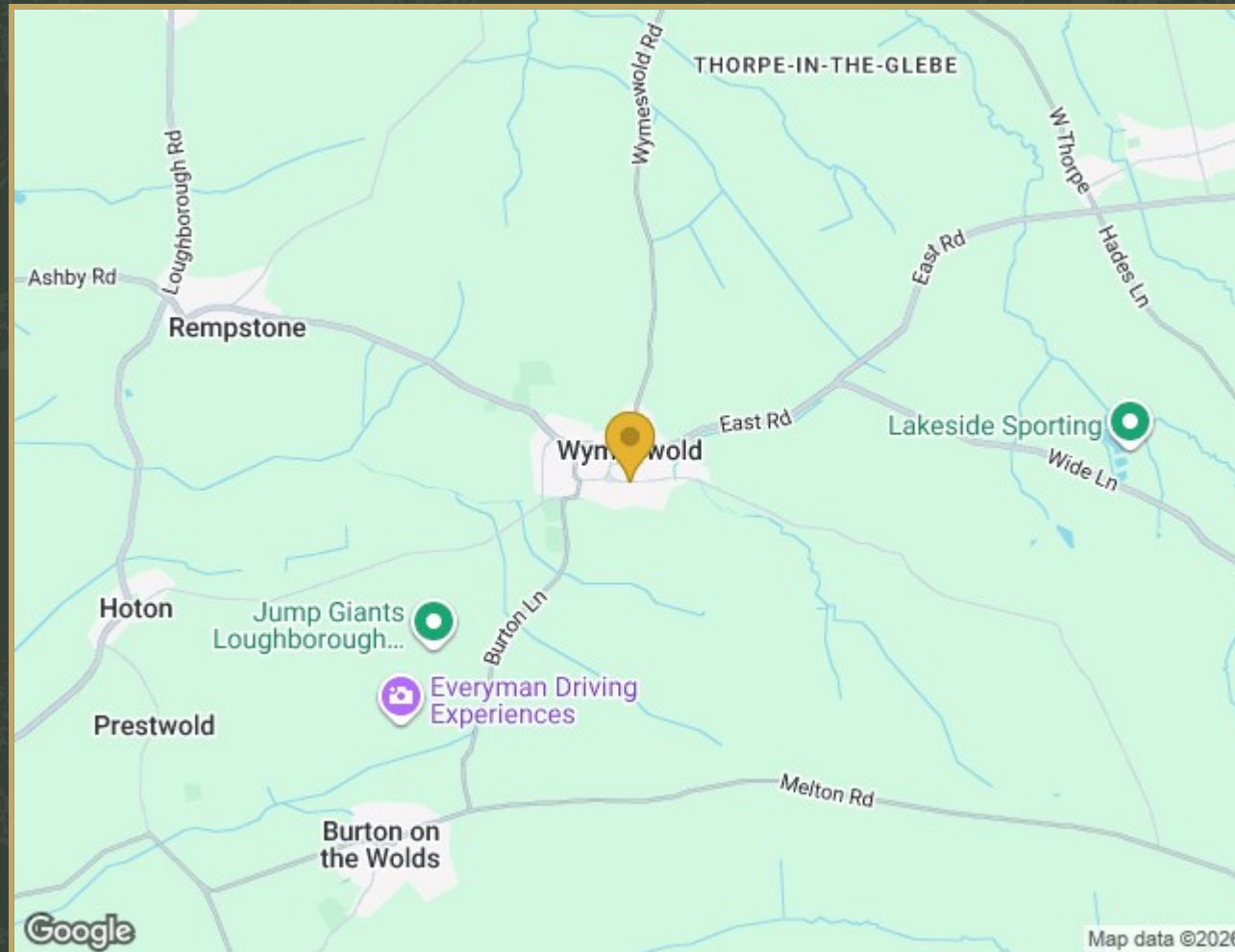
