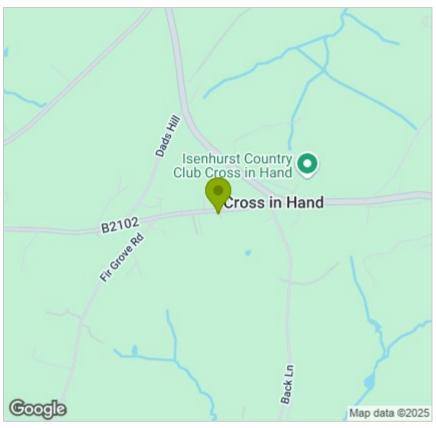
Floor Plan Area Map



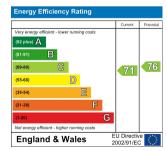
