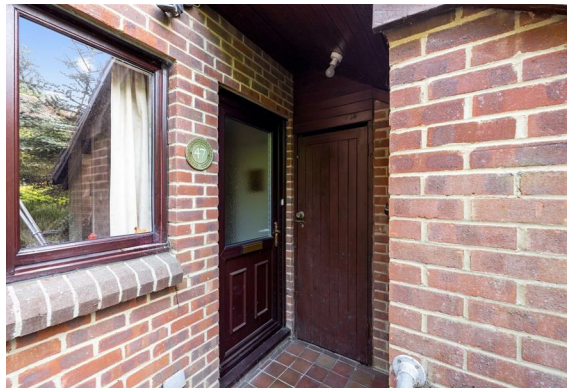

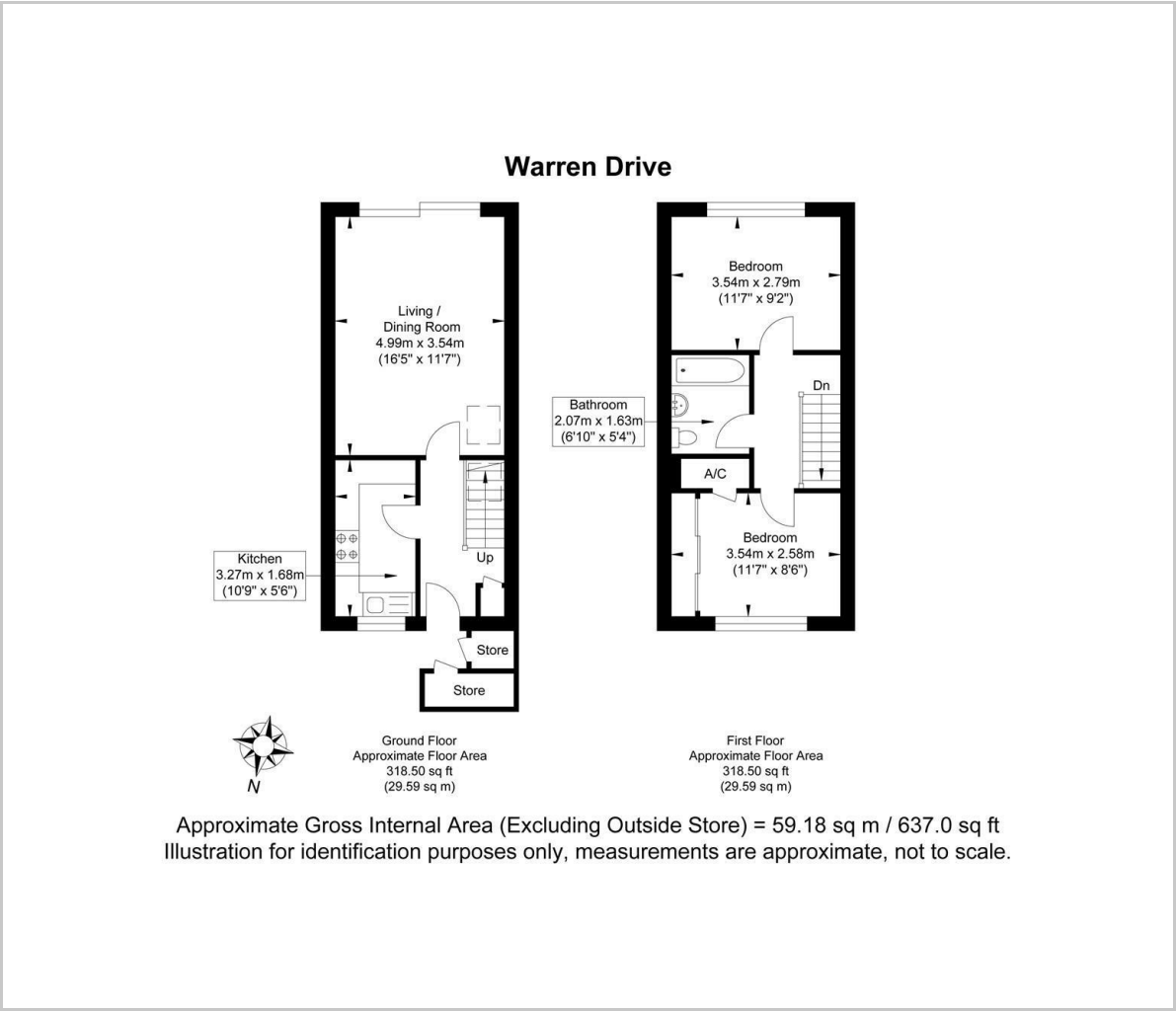

Floor Plan

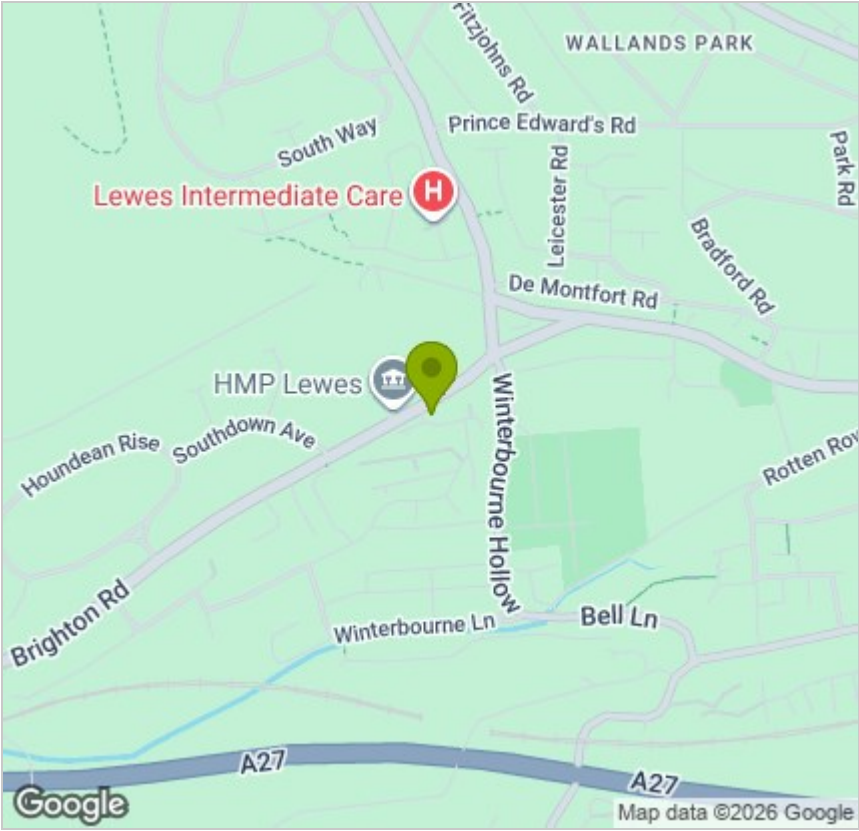
